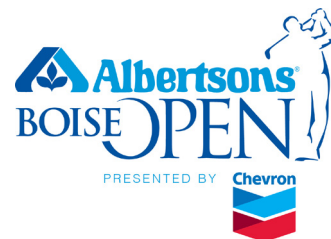

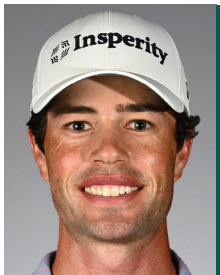
PLAYERS TO WATCH



Alistair Docherty rose to No. 4 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List and to the cusp of PGA TOUR membership for the first time with a runner-up finish at last week's Pinnacle Bank Championship presented by Woodhouse. Docherty won the 119th Visa Argentina Open presented by Macro earlier this season, a victory which earned him an exemption for the 2026 Open Championship.



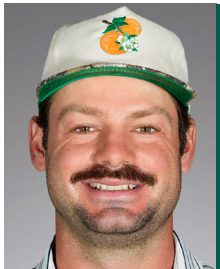
Hunter Eichhorn stands No. 8 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List off the strength of a runner-up finish at the Visit Knoxville Open, where he lost a playoff to Doc Redman. Eichhorn, who leads the Korn Ferry Tour with eight top-10s, grew up in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan, frequenting Wild Pines Golf Course -- a nine-hole course in Hermanville, Michigan -- with his grandpa. Later played collegiately at Marquette University (2017-22).



Cole Hammer stands No. 21 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, the first position out of PGA TOUR membership. Hammer, a former No. 1 in the World Amateur Golf Ranking who finished No. 5 in the 2022 PGA TOUR University Ranking, has four top-five finishes this season -- tied with Tommy Morrison and Ian Gilligan for the most such finishes on Tour.



Frankie Harris closed in 12-under 59 and defeated Alistair Docherty in a playoff for a historic win at last week's Pinnacle Bank Championship. Harris carded the 18th sub-60 round in Korn Ferry Tour history, tallied an 8-under 27 on the back nine (the 13th 9-hole score of 27 in Tour history), and recorded the lowest final round by a winner in Tour history. Harris, who earned Korn Ferry Tour membership with a No. 9 finish in the 2026 PGA TOUR University Ranking, rose to No. 29 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List.



Doc Redman reclaimed the No. 1 position on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List with a solo fourth at last week's Pinnacle Bank Championship presented by Woodhouse. Redman, the 2017 U.S. Amateur Championship winner, is in line to secure a return to the PGA TOUR, where he previously played four consecutive seasons (2019-23).

TOURNAMENT NOTES

- The 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season -- the 36th season in Tour history -- continues with the Albertsons Boise Open presented by Chevron, the 20th tournament of the 25-event schedule.
- Field includes 15 PGA TOUR winners with 25 career wins, led by three-time winners **Cameron Champ**, **Chez Reavie**, **Brendon Todd**.
- Field features 66 Korn Ferry Tour winners with 95 career victories, led by five-time winner **Ben Kohles**.
- Five past champions of the Albertsons Boise Open are in the field: **Kevin Tway** (2013), **Michael Thompson** (2016), **Matt NeSmith** (2019), **Will Gordon** (2022), **Chan Kim** (2023).
- There are 12 players in the field ranked inside the top 200 of the Official World Golf Ranking: **Ben Kohles** (No. 106), **Doc Redman** (No. 110), **Ross Steelman** (No. 133), **Zac Blair** (No. 147), **Ian Holt** (No. 152), **Cole Sherwood** (No. 155), **Alistair Docherty** (No. 162), **Davis Lamb** (No. 173), **Dylan Menante** (No. 174), **Jeremy Gandon** (No. 178), **Vince Whaley** (No. 189), **Carson Young** (No. 191).

2026 KEY STORYLINES

- **Doc Redman** and **Ian Holt**, Nos. 1 and 2 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, respectively, are the only multi-time winners this season. Should either win for a third time this season, they will earn an automatic promotion to the PGA TOUR via the Three-Victory Promotion. Matt McCarty (2024) was the last player to achieve the feat, earning his third victory at the 2024 Albertsons Boise Open presented by Chevron.
- Upon conclusion of the 25-event Korn Ferry Tour season, the top 20 players on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List will be awarded PGA TOUR cards (i.e. - membership) for the 2027 season. Additionally, the player who finishes No. 1 will earn exemptions for the 2027 PLAYERS Championship and 2027 U.S. Open.
- Of the current top 20 players on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, 16 would be earning PGA TOUR membership for the first time.
- Two players in the top 10 of the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List do not have a victory -- No. 8 **Hunter Eichhorn** and No. 9 **Michael Johnson**. Eichhorn leads the Tour with eight top-10s. Only two players finished the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Season with at least eight top-10s: No. 1 Johnny Keefer (nine) and No. 4 Neal Shipley (eight).
- 19-year-old Blades Brown, who stands No. 11 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, earned Special Temporary Membership for the remainder of the 2026 PGA TOUR Season, granting him a position in the Priority Ranking and enabling him to accept an unlimited number of sponsor exemptions. Brown has two top-10s on TOUR this season (3rd/Puerto Rico Open, T9/ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic).
- Following the Compliance Solutions Championship, the third of four season-ending Korn Ferry Tour Finals events, the top 60 players on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List will qualify for the Korn Ferry Tour Championship presented by Virginia's Richmond Region at The Federal Club in Glen Allen, Virginia. Those 60 players will also earn full status for the 2027 Korn Ferry Tour Season.
