Today – Increasing clouds today with a chance of a couple showers developing as a system moves in from the south, highest chances are after 3pm. An isolated t-storm cannot be ruled out. Calm winds this morning become light from the northwest this afternoon. Winds may become variable, gusty near any showers late in the day. Highs this afternoon reach near 86F and lows tonight fall to 62F.

Extended forecast – Friday, a chance of a few showers and isolated t-storms is possible in the area, highest chances prior to 9am and again after 4pm. Winds Friday will be light/variable in the morning, becoming light from the southeast in the afternoon. Brief gusty/erratic winds are possible with outflow from any vicinity showers and storms. Saturday, a chance of widely scattered showers/storms will again be possible, with the highest chances after 2pm. Southeast breezes are expected to come up slightly for Saturday. Sunday, conditions become less favorable for showers/storms, but some isolated activity still cannot be completely ruled out, mainly higher terrain areas in the afternoon/evening.
