




### THIS WEEK ON TOUR



**Alistair Docherty** made birdie on the 72nd hole of the 119th Visa Argentina Open presented by Macro to capture his first Korn Ferry Tour victory in his 82nd start, rising to No. 2 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List. By virtue of his win, Docherty earns an exemption for the 154th Open Championship via The Open Qualifying Series.



Vina Del Mar, Chile native **Cristobal Del Solar** will make his third career start at the Astara Chile Classic presented by Scotiabank. Del Solar's best finish at the event came in the form of a T32 in 2024, a season that culminated in him earning his first PGA TOUR card with a No. 14 finish on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List (Top 30 earned PGA TOUR cards).



Reigning champion **Logan McAllister** returns to the Astara Chile Classic presented by Scotiabank. With a winning score of 19-under 265 (68-70-63-64), McAllister recorded the lowest 72-hole score in six iterations at Prince of Wales Country Club en route to his victory last season. This season, McAllister has made two cuts in four starts, highlighted by a T8 at the season-opening The Bahamas Golf Classic at Atlantis Paradise Island.



Conditional member **Chris Korte** finished T2 at the 119th Visa Argentina Open presented by Macro for his best finish in five career starts on Tour. Korte has ascended to No. 13 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points over his past two starts off the strength of his T2 and a T25 finish at the Astara Golf Championship presented by Mastercard.



**Ian Gilligan**, a second-year member out of the University of Florida, recorded his third consecutive top-10 finish with a T9 at the 119th Visa Argentina Open presented by Macro. Gilligan's three top-10s matches Hunter Eichhorn for the most on Tour. In his rookie campaign, Gilligan recorded one top-10 all of last season in 11 starts.

### TOURNAMENT NOTES

- The 2026 Korn Ferry Tour season continues with the Astara Chile Classic presented by Scotiabank, the sixth tournament of the 25-event schedule and the fourth of five events to be contested in Latin America.
- This will mark the eighth playing of the Astara Chile Classic presented by Scotiabank.
- Prince of Wales Country Club will play host to the event for the seventh time, and for the fourth consecutive season.
- **Long McAllister** earned his first career Korn Ferry Tour victory at the 2025 Astara Chile Classic presented by Scotiabank. With a final round 7-under 64, McAllister captured a one-stroke victory over runner-up and 2025 Korn Ferry Tour graduate Davis Chatfield. McAllister, who began the 2025 season with conditional membership, secured full Korn Ferry Tour status for the remainder of the 2025 and 2026 seasons with his win. He went on to finish No. 29 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List.
- Field includes three PGA TOUR winners with six total victories, led by three-time winner **Chez Reavie**.
- Field includes 47 Korn Ferry Tour winners - including all four winners from the 2026 season- with 64 career victories, led by **Robby Shelton** with four wins.
- Three players in the field stand inside the top 200 of the Official World Golf Ranking: **Ian Holt** (No. 106), **Alistair Docherty** (No. 189), and **Barend Botha** (No. 200).
- Field features five Chileans, including 2024 Korn Ferry Tour graduate **Cristobal Del Solar**, as well as 18-year-old Martin Sandoval, who is making his first PGA TOUR-sanctioned start this week as a sponsor exemption.

### 2026 KEY STORYLINES

- **Ian Holt** stands No. 1 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List through five events off the strength of his back-to-back victories at The Bahamas Great Abaco Classic at The Abaco Club and The Panama Championship. With a third victory, Holt would earn an automatic promotion to the PGA TOUR via the Three-Victory Promotion.
- The 2026 Korn Ferry Tour season, the 36th in the Tour's history, will feature 25 events across seven countries and 15 states. There will be 10 televised events throughout the season.
- **Alistair Docherty** won last week's 119th Visa Argentina Open presented by Macro. As part of The Open Qualifying Series, the victory earned Docherty an exemption for the 154th Open Championship at Royal Birkdale this July.
- Two new events are featured on the 2026 schedule: Colonial Life Charity Classic (May 14-17) in Columbia, South Carolina, and the OccuNet Classic presented by Amarillo National Bank (June 11-14) in Amarillo, Texas.
- At the conclusion of the 25-event Korn Ferry Tour season, the top 20 players on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List will be awarded PGA TOUR cards (i.e. - membership) for the 2027 season. Additionally, the player who finishes No. 1 on the Points List will earn exemptions for the 2027 PLAYERS Championship and 2027 U.S. Open.
- Following the Compliance Solutions Championship, the third of four season-ending Korn Ferry Tour Finals events, the top 60 players on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List will qualify for the Korn Ferry Tour Championship presented by Virginia's Richmond Region at The Federal Club in Glen Allen, Virginia. Those 60 players will also earn full status for the 2027 Korn Ferry Tour season.
