Doc Redman (T1/-9)

- Cards a 5-under 66 in the second round and holds his first 36-hole lead/co-lead in what is his 52nd Korn Ferry Tour start (previous career high 36-hole hole position: T2/2024 Korn Ferry Tour Championship presented by Virginia’s Richmond Region/finished T2)
- One of four players to make the cut in all six events of the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season (Ian Holt, Jorge Fernández Valdés, and Caleb VanArragon)
- Retained Korn Ferry Tour membership for the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season with a T34 finish at Final Stage of 2025 PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry
- Held Korn Ferry Tour membership the past two seasons, with previous Korn Ferry Tour Points List finishes of No. 37 (2024) and No. 138 (2025)
- Played four full seasons on the PGA TOUR after initially earning status via a solo-second finish at the 2019 Rocket Classic, which earned him enough non-member FedExCup points to qualify for Special Temporary Membership; He initially earned his start at the 2019 Rocket Classic through open qualifying
- Played two seasons at Clemson University (2016-18)

Davis Shore (T1/-9)

- Records a 4-under 67 to take his first career 36-hole lead/co-lead in his 54th start on Tour (previous career high 36-hole position: T5/117th Visa Argentina Open presented by Macro/finished T44)
- Owns four made cuts in five starts on Tour this season, highlighted by a T14 finish at the Astara Golf Championship presented by Mastercard
- Holds full status for the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour season after a No. 39 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List

- As a rookie, finished No. 73 on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List to secure full status for the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour season after beginning the 2024 season with conditional membership
- Earned conditional membership for the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Season with a T81 finish at Final Stage of 2023 PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry
- Played four seasons at the University of Alabama (2017-21)

Augusto Núñez (T1/-9)

- Cards a bogey-free 3-under 68 and makes his first cut of the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season in his fourth start
- Holds his second 36-hole lead/co-lead in what is his 149th start on the Korn Ferry Tour (T1/2024 The Panama Championship/finished T27)
- Holds conditional status for the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season after a No. 78 finish on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List
- Earned PGA TOUR membership for the first time with a No. 12 finish on the 2022 Korn Ferry Tour Points List
- In his lone season on TOUR, he logged 14 made cuts in 32 starts with a best finish of T15 at the 2023 Puerto Rico Open
- Three-time winner on PGA TOUR Lationamérica in 87 career starts

Additional Notes

- Rookie **Chad Sewell** (T6/-7) cards a 6-under 65 and logs a new career-high 36-hole position, usurping his previous best that he set at last week's 119th Visa Argentina Open presented by Macro (T8/finished T9); earned Korn Ferry Tour membership for the first time this season via a T34 finish at Final Stage of 2025 PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry
- Class of 2024 Korn Ferry Tour graduate **Cristobal Del Solar** (T17/-5), a native of Vina Del Mar, Chile, cards a 5-under 66 with seven birdies against two bogeys to move inside the 36-hole cut line
- Two-time Korn Ferry Tour winner **Ian Holt** (T17/-5), who stands No. 1 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, makes a hole-in-one on the par-3 15th en route to a 2-under 69
- Argentine amateur Segundo Oliva Pinto (T30/-2), who qualified for this week's event with a T7 finish at the 119th Visa Argentina Open presented by Macro last week, is the first amateur to make the 36-hole cut in consecutive Korn Ferry Tour events since Noah Norton during the 2020-21 season (2021 Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas Wichita Open presented by Syndeo/finished T8; 2021 Club Car Championship at the Landings Golf & Athletic Club/finished T66)
