### TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- Established in 2010, the Astara Golf Championship presented by Mastercard is one of five events contested in Latin America on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour schedule.
- From 2019 through 2025, the Astara Golf Championship presented by Mastercard was contested on two courses at Country Club de Bogotá (Lagos and Pacos), with the field playing one round on each course for the first 36 holes. The event returned to its original single-course format in 2026, playing exclusively on the Lagos course.
- In the first round of the 2024 Astara Golf Championship presented by Mastercard, Cristobal Del Solar recorded a 13-under 57 on the Pacos course, marking the lowest 18-hole score in PGA TOUR-sanctioned history.



- In his 61st Korn Ferry Tour start, Kyle Westmoreland converted a two-stroke 54-hole solo lead into his first Korn Ferry Tour title. Westmoreland held the outright 54-hole lead over Johnny Keefer, as both carded 10-under 61s in the third round and broke the 18-hole tournament scoring record for the Lagos course at Country Club de Bogotá.
- Westmoreland, a Class of 2022 Korn Ferry Tour graduate, went on to finish No. 34 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points off the strength of his victory and two additional top-10 finishes.
- Five of the top 10 finishers eventually finished in the top 20 of the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List and earned PGA TOUR membership for the 2026 season: Pierceson Coody (T2), Christo Lamprecht (T2), Johnny Keefer (T4), Davis Chatfield (T6), S.T. Lee (T6). Keefer finished No. 1 in the 2025 standings.
- Mitchell Meissner eventually finished No. 21 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, making him the first man out of PGA TOUR membership for the 2026 season, as the top 20 finishers from the standings earned TOUR cards.
