Partial Third-Round Notes – Saturday, February 7, 2026

The second round resumed at 6:59 a.m. Saturday and was completed at 10:15 a.m. ET. The third round was suspended due to inclement weather at 2:09 p.m., resumed at 5:27 p.m. and then was suspended due to darkness at 6:01 p.m. The third round will resume on Sunday at 6:45 a.m., with 73 players needing to complete the third round. Players will not be re-paired for the Final-round, which will start at approx. 8:15 a.m. off No. 1 and 10 tees.

Cut: 73 professionals at 2-under 140 from a field of 144 professionals

Weather: Partly cloudy with scattered thunderstorms. High of 68. Wind W 5-10 mph. Preferred lies were in use for round three.

Ashton Van Horne (1st/-1 thru 7)

- Cards 1-under thru 7 holes during the third round before play was suspended due to inclement weather
- Would hold first career 54-hole lead/co-lead on Tour if his position remains at the conclusion of round three (previous best 54-hole position: T13, *two times*; most recent: 2022 Utah Championship presented by Zions Bank/finished T2)
- Sets career low 36-hole score after 65-65--130 (previous best: 131/2023 Utah Championship presented by Zions Bank/finished T29)
- Competing via medical extension (hip injury) and is making his first start on Tour since the 2025 Tulum Championship at PGA Riviera Maya last May (MC)
- Making third appearance at the Astar Golf Championship presented by Mastercard (T57/2023, T49/2025)
- Turned professional in 2016, he was awarded exempt status for the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour season after tying for first in second stage of 2024 PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry

- Played four seasons at Belmont University from 2012-16, becoming the first Belmont golfer to compete in a NCAA Championship, garnering 2016 OVC Player of the Year recognition, as well as Belmont Athletic Hall of Fame, Class of 2024 honors

Additional Player Notes

- **James Nicholas** (2nd/-12), who finished No. 64 in the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List sits at 3-under during the third round with 11 holes left to play; T3 marks his career-best finish on Tour (2025 Compliance Solutions Championship)
- **Ricardo Celia** (T37/-5), who is a conditional member sits at Even-par thru 14* during the third round with four holes left to play; the Barranquilla, Colombia native's best finish in five starts at the Astara Golf Championship presented by Mastercard was in 2019 (T25)
- **Camilo Villegas** (T47/-4), who is a native of Medellin, Colombia, sits at 1-under thru 12* during the third round; five-time PGA TOUR winner holds Korn Ferry Tour membership this season via a T7 finish at Final Stage of 2025 PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry, where he fell one stroke shy of a playoff for a PGA TOUR card
