Thursday – This morning will begin clear, warming to the upper 60s by the early afternoon. Thunderstorms may develop as early as 12-1pm, but by 2-3pm, thunderstorms will be common. These will produce heavy downpours, and small hail is additionally possible. Winds will be light and variable until they turn to the west which will coincide with the increasing threat of thunderstorms today.

Extended forecast – Saturday will be very similar to Friday, with heavy rain and thunderstorms expected after 1-2pm. On Sunday, rain and thunderstorm chances remain in the afternoon, but the chances are overall lower with less rainfall expected. While Monday does not have as high of chances as thunderstorms, rain showers will remain possible in the afternoon. Winds each day will be variable less than 10mph, until the afternoon when the winds turn to the west leading to the rain and thunderstorms. Temperatures will range from the low 50s each morning and to the middle to upper 60s each afternoon.
