**Wednesday** – Dry conditions are forecast this morning. Clouds will build in throughout the morning and afternoon. After 2pm, rain showers will become possible, with highest chances near 4-5pm. A brief heavy rain shower or thunderstorm cannot be ruled out. Winds will begin from the SE and turn to the W in the late afternoon near 5-10mph. Wind gusts to 15mph are expected. Temperatures will rise to near 70F again today. **Rainfall: 0.10-0.20"** | **Sunrise: 6:12am** / **Sunset: 6:08pm**

**Extended forecast** – Friday through Sunday, after 1-2pm each afternoon thunderstorms and heavy rain showers will be common. A chance of small hail is possible, primarily on Friday. Rainfall from these thunderstorms can quickly produce at least 0.50" of rain. While Monday does not have as high of chances as thunderstorms, rain showers will remain possible in the afternoon. Winds each day will be variable less than 10mph, until the afternoon when the winds turn to the west leading to the rain and thunderstorms. Temperatures will range from the low 50s each morning and to the middle to upper 60s each afternoon.
