John Pak (1st/-11)

- Opens with a career-low 11-under 61 (previous best: 63/four occurrences) and breaks the single-round tournament scoring record at the Club Car Championship at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club (previous 18-hole tournament scoring record: 62/Julián Etulian/2020/Round 2)
- Holds first 18-hole lead/co-lead of his Korn Ferry Tour career in what is his 44th start (previous 18-hole high position: T2/2024 Compliance Solutions Championship/Won)
- Owns five made cuts through six starts on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season, highlighted by a T12 at the Astara Golf Championship presented by Mastercard in Bogota, Colombia
- Finished T3 at the 2024 Club Car Championship at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club, his only made cut in two previous starts at the event
- Class of 2024 Korn Ferry Tour graduate earned his first PGA TOUR card with a No. 23 finish on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, primarily off the strength of his victory at the 2024 Compliance Solutions Championship
- As a PGA TOUR rookie, finished No. 152 in the 2025 FedExCup Fall, recording three top-25 finishes and a top 10 in 26 starts
- Finished No. 145 on the 2022 Korn Ferry Tour Points List as a rookie
- Made 10 starts during the 2023 PGA TOUR Canada Season, finishing No. 8 in the Order of Merit, highlighted by a win at the 2023 Elk Ridge Saskatchewan Open presented by Lake Country Co-Op
- Finished No. 1 in the inaugural PGA TOUR University Class of 2021 after four seasons at Florida State (2017-21), collecting eight individual wins and All-America honors all four seasons (first-team selection in 2019 and 2021, second-team honoree in 2020, and third-team selection in 2018)

Additional Notes

- **Ian Gilligan** (2nd/-10), who finished No. 4 in the PGA TOUR University Class of 2025, made seven of his 11 birdies on his back nine en route to a 10-under 62, logging a new high first-round position (previous career high 18-hole position: T5/2025 Evans Scholar Invitational/MC)
- Korn Ferry Tour winner **Kevin Velo** (T3/-8), a Class of 2024 Korn Ferry Tour graduate, opens with an 8-under 64 and stands inside the top five through 18 holes in an individual stroke play event for the first time since the 2024 LECOM Suncoast Classic (T4/finished T30)
- Sponsor Exemption and Pepperdine University senior Mahanth Chirravuri (T5/-7), who stands No. 6 in the 2026 PGA TOUR University Ranking, opens with a bogey-free 7-under 65 with five birdies (Nos. 1, 3, 4, 6, 11) and an eagle (No. 5) in his Korn Ferry Tour debut
- Korn Ferry Tour winner **Bryson Nimmer** (T10/-6), who finished No. 47 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, holds his best 18-hole position at the Club Car Championship at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club in his fourth start (previous high 18-hole position at Club Car Championship: 2025/T29/finished T69)
