John Pak (T1/-16)

- 36-hole solo-leader cards a 1-under 71 with two birdies (Nos. 6, 15) and one bogey (No. 13)
- With a 36-hole score of 15-under 129, broke the 36-hole tournament scoring record of 131 held by Kevin Dougherty (2020), Evan Harmeling (2020) and Erik Barnes (2022)
- Opened with a career-low 11-under 61 (previous best: 63/four occurrences), breaking the single-round tournament scoring record (previous 18-hole tournament scoring record: 62/Julián Etulian/2020/Round 2)
- Converted his only other 54-hole lead/co-lead into his first Korn Ferry Tour victory at the 2024 Compliance Solutions Championship
- Owns five made cuts through six starts on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season, highlighted by a T12 at the Astara Golf Championship presented by Mastercard in Bogota, Colombia
- Makes his second cut in his third start at the Club Car Championship at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club; finished T3 in his only other made cut at the event (2024)
- Earned his first PGA TOUR card with a No. 23 finish on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List off the strength of his victory at the Compliance Solutions Championship, as well as six additional top-25 finishes
- As a PGA TOUR rookie, finished No. 152 in the 2025 FedExCup Fall, recording three top-25 finishes and a top 10 in 26 starts
- Finished No. 145 on the 2022 Korn Ferry Tour Points List as a rookie
- Finished No. 1 in the inaugural PGA TOUR University Class of 2021 after four seasons at Florida State (2017-21), collecting eight individual wins and All-America honors all four seasons (first-team selection in 2019 and 2021, second-team honoree in 2020, and third-team selection in 2018)

Blades Brown (T1/-16)

- Made a birdie on the par-5 18th to card a 5-under 67 to grab a share of the 54-hole lead for the first time in his career
- At 18 years, 10 months, 7 days becomes the youngest 54-hole leader/co-leader in a Korn Ferry Tour event, surpassing Óscar Serna, who held the solo lead at the 1998 Monterrey Open at 19 years, 5 months, 16 days (finished T8)
- Bidding to become the youngest winner in Korn Ferry Tour history, a title currently held by Aldrich Potgeiter, who won the 2024 The Bahamas Great Abaco Classic at The Abaco Club at 19 years, 4 months, 11 days
- Turned professional in 2024 and earned special temporary membership for the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Season; finished No. 68 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, including four top-25s in 14 starts, to secure full status for the 2026 season
- Owns three made cuts in four Korn Ferry Tour starts this season, including two top-25 finishes, and stands No. 73 on the 2026 Points List
- Made his first Korn Ferry Tour start at the 2025 Club Car Championship at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club, finishing T41
- Made four starts on the PGA TOUR this season, highlighted by a solo-third finish at the 2026 Puerto Rico Open and a T18 at the 2026 American Express
- Carded a round of 12-under 60 on the PGA West Nicklaus Tournament Course in the second round of the 2026 American Express, setting the 18-hole tournament scoring record for the Nicklaus Tournament Course and usurping Patrick Cantlay as the youngest player in PGA TOUR history to record a round of 60 or better

Additional Notes

- **Davis Lamb** (3rd/-15), who finished No. 3 on the 2025 PGA TOUR Americas Points List, stands in the top three through 54 holes for the first time in his Korn Ferry Tour career; he had never stood higher than T10 in 33 previous starts on Tour (2024 Astara Chile Classic presented by Scotiabank/finished T11; 2024 Veritex Bank Championship/finished T22)
- **Drew Nesbitt** (T58/-5), who finished No. 8 on the 2025 PGA TOUR Americas Points List, made a hole-in-one on the par-3 17th with a 7-iron from 181 yards
