**Thursday** – Any fog should lift off the course around sunrise, and much warmer weather is in store for today. Cloud cover is expected to decrease throughout the morning leading to mostly clear skies and temperatures in the upper 70s by the afternoon. Winds will turn from the northeast to the southeast throughout the day. As the sea breeze moves over the course in the afternoon a few wind gusts of 20mph are possible. **Sunrise: 7:20am/Sunset: 7:40pm**

**Extended forecast** – Dry and calm conditions will continue on Friday. In the afternoon a sea breeze may pass over the course and a few wind gusts up to 20mph from the SE are possible. Another cold front is expected on Saturday, but most of the rain showers are expected to remain offshore. Dry conditions return on Sunday. Winds are expected to pick back up with 20-30 mph wind gusts Saturday and 20-25mph wind gusts on Sunday. Winds will weaken on Monday. Temperatures this week will increase Thursday and Friday before falling again on Saturday and Sunday.
