Carson Young (T1/-12)

- Opened his round with 13 straight pars before playing Nos. 14-17 in 7-under (eagle-birdie-birdie-albatross); holed a 4-iron from 233 yards on the 542-yard, par-5 17th. His 7-under 63 was the best third-round score.
- This marks his third 54-hole lead/co-lead in PGA TOUR-sanctioned competition and first on the Korn Ferry Tour; last year at the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic, he led by one entering the final round and finished T13 after a Sunday 73.
- Entered the week No. 24 on the Korn Ferry Tour Points List off the strength of two top-five finishes:
 - 3rd/Astara Golf Championship presented by Mastercard
 - 5th/Club Car Championship at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club
- As a conditional member on the PGA TOUR (Finishers 126-150 from 2025 FedExCup Fall Standings), currently No. 180 in the FedExCup with five made cuts in six starts.
- Played full-time on the PGA TOUR for three seasons (2023-25), posting 19 top-25s across 92 starts; earned his TOUR card via the 2022 Korn Ferry Tour season, highlighted by a win at the 2022 Panama Championship.
- Played four seasons at Clemson University (2013-16) where he was a two-time All-ACC First Team selection.
- Won the South Carolina Amateur when it was played at The Woodcreek Club in 2013.

Cole Sherwood (T1/-12)

- Carded a bogey-free 64 Saturday to move into a share of the lead; this marks the first time he has led/co-led after any round in PGA TOUR-sanctioned competition.
- Through three rounds, leads the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (7.073).
- Last year in his first full season on the Korn Ferry Tour, finished No. 41 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List with top-three finishes at the 118th Visa Argentina Open presented by Macro (T2) and Club Car Championship

at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club (T3). Earned full status for the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season (top 75 from Korn Ferry Tour Points List).

- Finished No. 7 in the 2024 PGA TOUR University Ranking after four seasons at Vanderbilt University (2020-24), earning conditional membership for the remainder of the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour season.

Josh Teater (T1/-12)

- His third-round 64 ended with a three-putt bogey on the par-4 18th, dropping him into a three-way tie for the lead at 12-under.
- This marks his fourth lead/co-lead entering the final round on Korn Ferry Tour (Last: 2023 BMW Charity Pro-Am presented by TD SYNEX, finished T2).
- At the 2009 Utah Championship presented by Zions Bank and Intermountain Health, converted a one-stroke lead after three rounds into a four-stroke victory, his first of two wins on the Korn Ferry Tour.

Additional Notes

- Open qualifier **Jamie Wilson**, an alumnus of University of South Carolina (2016-21), carded a third-round 66 and is T12 at 7-under.
- **Sam Choi** carded a bogey-free 65 and is T6 at 9-under; currently a conditional member (Second Stage Medalist and Ties from 2025 PGA TOUR Q-School) and stands to improve his position in the reorder, which will take place after the Colonial Life Charity Classic.
- Two albatrosses were made on the par-5 17th hole in the third round – in addition to Young, **Ben Martin** made a 2 en route to an even-par 70.
- Six players currently ranked in the top 20 on the season-long points list are in the top 15 on the leaderboard:
 - T6, **Ian Gilligan** (No. 11 points list)
 - T9, **Michael Johnson** (No. 9)
 - T15, **Blades Brown** (No. 10)
 - T15, **Cooper Dossey** (No. 12)
 - T15, **Doc Redman** (No. 5)
