Thursday – Mostly sunny conditions will begin the day. Late in the afternoon around 4-5pm, some scattered thunderstorms may move into the area. These could produce briefly heavy downpours. Winds will be similar to the last few days, steady from the east near 10mph, with wind gusts up to 20mph in the afternoon. Temperatures will reach the mid 80s prior to any rain or thunderstorms.

Extended forecast – The sea breeze/pop-up thunderstorm pattern may return Friday through the weekend. The mornings will remain mostly sunny, but between 3-5pm each afternoon if a sea breeze develops, it may bring pop-up thunderstorms to the area. Winds will remain from the east-southeast with wind gusts up to 20mph each day. Temperatures each afternoon will rise into the upper 80s. Overnight Sunday into Monday a cold front is expected to pass through the area changing the wind direction to the NW, and bringing a chance of scattered thunderstorms in the afternoon.
