Will Cannon (1st/-17)

- Cards a career-low 10-under 61 with nine birdies and an eagle against one bogey (previous career low: 62/2025 Compliance Solutions Championship/R2)
- Holds the second 36-hole lead/co-lead of his career in his 85th start on Tour (previous: 2018 LECOM Health Challenge/finished T9)
- Began the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour season with conditional membership, following a No. 79 finish on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List
- Owns five made cuts in 10 starts on Tour this season, highlighted by a T17 at the LECOM Suncoast Classic
- Finished No. 6 on the 2024 PGA TOUR Americas Points list, primarily off the strength of his victory at the season-ending PGA Oceans 4 Tour Championship presented by Scotiabank, securing a return to the Korn Ferry Tour for the 2025 season
- Recorded previous finishes of No. 118 (2019) and No. 129 (2021) on the Korn Ferry Tour Points List
- Improves to 5-for-5 in cuts made at the Memorial Health Championship presented by LRS (best finish: T23/2025)
- Played four seasons at the University of Alabama-Birmingham (2012-16) before turning professional in 2016
- Hilton Head Island, South Carolina native, who resides in Birmingham, Alabama

Additional Notes

- Canadian **Drew Nesbitt** (2nd/-16), who held the 18-hole solo lead, establishes a new 36-hole high position; previously had not stood higher than T38 (2026 LECOM Suncoast Classic/finished T38)
- **Frankie Harris** (3rd/-13), who finished No. 9 in the PGA TOUR University Class of 2026, remains bogey-free through 36 holes following a 5-under 66 in the second round
- **Michael Johnson** (4th/-12), who stands No. 9 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, makes his fifth career cut at the Memorial Health Championship in what is his eighth start at the event (best finish: T8/2024)
- First-year member **Hunter Eichhorn** (T5/-11) stands inside the top five after 36 holes for the sixth time this season; he's finished outside the top-10 once in five previous instances (T17/BMW Charity Pro-Am)
- **Jackson Buchanan** (T10/-10), who played four seasons at the University of Illinois (2021-25), improves to 3-for-3 in cuts made at the Memorial Health Championship (best finish: T34/2025)
- Korn Ferry Tour winner **Mason Andersen** (T10/-10), who stands No. 35 on the 2026 Points List, makes his first cut at the Memorial Health Championship in his third career start at the event following a 9-under 62 second round
- Of the eight open qualifiers, only Tyler Johnson (T53/-6) advanced to the weekend, marking his first made cut on the Korn Ferry Tour in his second career start
