Friday – Light rain showers will continue this morning through roughly 10am as weaker bands move through the area. Around late-morning and through the afternoon a wave of much higher moisture will arrive leading to more widespread rain and higher chances of thunderstorms. Winds will generally be from the SE, but wind speeds may be elevated in periods of heavy rain. Temperatures will not increase much today only reaching the low-mid 70s.

Extended forecast – Most of Saturday is expected to be dry but thunderstorms are possible late in the day and overnight. Sunday and Monday are then expected to be mostly dry and hot. Winds will generally remain near 10mph with wind gusts less than 20mph throughout the weekend. Temperatures will warm this weekend reaching the low 90s and the heat index approaching 100F on Sunday and Monday.
