

Korn Ferry Tour Tournament History

Nationwide Children's Hospital Championship

2026 marks the 20th playing of the event

TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- The Nationwide Children's Hospital Championship is one of the premier Korn Ferry Tour events, as it was named the 2025 Tournament of the Year, and Nationwide Children's Hospital was recognized as the 2024 Charity of the Year at the annual Korn Ferry Tour Tournament Awards.
- Ohio State University Golf Club's Scarlet Course finished among the top five toughest courses on Tour (measured by scoring average relative to par) nine times since 2007, the first playing of the event: 2007 (No. 3), 2008 (No. 5), 2009 (No. 5), 2010 (No. 5), 2013 (No. 4), 2014 (No. 1), 2015 (No. 3), 2023 (No. 2), 2025 (No. 4).
- Nine past champions of the event went on to earn PGA TOUR titles: Bill Lunde (2008), Derek Lamely (2009), Harris English (2011), S.Y. Noh (2013), Justin Thomas (2014), Grayson Murray (2016), Robert Streb (2018), Scottie Scheffler (2019), Adam Svensson (2021).
- Justin Thomas and Scottie Scheffler, the 2014 and 2019 winners of the Nationwide Children's Hospital Championship, both went on to win THE PLAYERS Championship, with Thomas winning the title in 2021 and Scheffler winning back-to-back titles in 2023 and 2024.
- Daniel Summerhays (2007) and Harris English (2011) are two of the three amateurs to win a Korn Ferry Tour event since the Tour's inaugural season in 1990.

- John VanDerLaan converted a one-stroke 54-hole lead into a three-stroke victory for his first Korn Ferry Tour title, which propelled him a No. 17 finish on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List and PGA TOUR membership for the first time.
- VanDerLaan tied the 18-hole tournament scoring record with an opening-round 9-under 62, and tied the 72-hole tournament scoring record as he totaled 17-under 267.
- Trent Phillips recorded the third runner-up finish of his Korn Ferry Tour career and finished No. 27 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, retaining full status for the 2026 season.
- Five of the seven players who finished T16 or higher eventually finished in the top 20 of the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, earning PGA TOUR membership for the 2026 season: John VanDerLaan (Won), Zecheng Dou (T2), Chandler Blanchet (T4), Jeffrey Kang (T4), S.T. Lee (T6).
