Dylan Menante (1st/-19)

- Cards a bogey-free 9-under 63 – an 18-hole tournament scoring record – to capture his first Korn Ferry Tour victory in his 31st start (previous best finish: T3/2025 Visit Knoxville Open)
 - Marks the lowest final-round score by a winner of the 2026 season (previous: Jeremy Gandon/LECOM Suncoast Classic/65)
- At 19-under 269, breaks the 72-hole tournament scoring record of 279 (Bryson Nimmer, Stuart Macdonald/2025)
- Six-stroke margin of victory is the largest of the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour season (previous: Doc Redman/five strokes), and the largest on Tour since the 2025 Compliance Solutions Championship (Adrien Dumont de Chassart/seven strokes)
- Becomes the sixth first-time winner of the 2026 season, joining Ian Holt (Bahamas Great Abaco Classic at The Abaco Club), James Nicholas (Astara Golf Championship presented by Mastercard), Alistair Docherty (119th Visa Argentina Open presented by Macro), Doc Redman (Astara Chile Classic presented by Scotiabank) and Davis Lamb (Club Car Championship at the Landings Golf & Athletic Club)
- Earned full status for the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season with a No. 53 finish on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List after beginning the season with conditional membership
- Earned conditional membership for the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour season with a T72 at Final Stage of 2024 PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry after advancing through Second Stage
- Made 10 starts during the 2024 PGA TOUR Americas season, logging four top-25 finishes and a top 10 en route to a No. 70 finish on the points list

- Finished No. 15 in the PGA TOUR University Class of 2024 to earn PGA TOUR Americas membership for the 2024 season, following three seasons at Pepperdine University (2019-22) and two at the University of North Carolina (2022-24), where he completed his collegiate career

Additional Notes

- 54-hole leader **Blades Brown** (2nd/-13), who finished No. 68 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, records his second top-five finish of the 2026 season (solo third/Club Car Championship) and third such finish on the Korn Ferry Tour (previous: T2/2025 Veritex Bank Championship)
- **Sandy Scott** (3rd/-12), who finished No. 55 on the 2025 Points List as a rookie, matches his career-best finish on the Korn Ferry Tour (T3/2025 Memorial Health Championship presented by LRS)
- **Ben Carr** (8th/-8), who began the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season with conditional membership, records his second top-10 finish of the season and of his career (T7/Club Car Championship)
- Conditional members **Ricardo Celia** (T9/-7), **Travis Trace** (T13/-6) and **Jacob Solomon** (T22/-4) all earn starts at the Colonial Life Charity Championship via their top-25 finishes this week
 - Celia closes in 5-under 67 to record the best of his career in his 20th start on the Korn Ferry Tour (previous: T25/2019 Astara Golf Championship)
- Sponsor exemption Eugenio Chacarra (T9/-7), who made his Korn Ferry Tour debut this week, earned a start in the next Korn Ferry Tour event (Colonial Life Charity Classic) by virtue of his top-25 finish
