

TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- Now in its 10th year on the Korn Ferry Tour schedule, the Pinnacle Bank Championship presented by Woodhouse is known as one of the truest tests on Tour, with The Club at Indian Creek serving as the host venue all 10 years.
- The Club at Indian Creek has finished among the top 10 toughest courses on Tour five times, including three appearances in the top five: 2019 (No. 5), 2020 (No. 5), and 2024 (No. 5).
- While the Pinnacle Bank Championship presented by Woodhouse was established in 2017, the Korn Ferry Tour previously contested an event in Nebraska -- the Omaha Classic -- from 1996 through 2013.
- David Skinns (2018, 2021) is one of 16 players in Korn Ferry Tour history to win the same event multiple times.

Matt McCarty won the 2024 Pinnacle Bank Championship (pictured left), his second of three wins for the season. Two weeks later, McCarty won the Albertsons Boise Open and achieved the Three-Victory Promotion, earning him an immediate promotion to the PGA TOUR. McCarty won the 2024 Bank of Utah Championship (pictured right) in his second start as a member, following Jason Gore as the second player in history to achieve the Three-Victory Promotion and win on TOUR in the same season.

- Christo Lamprecht earned his first Korn Ferry Tour title with a birdie on the 72nd hole of regulation, as he holed out from the greenside bunker of the par-4 18th.
- The victory propelled Lamprecht to a No. 9 finish on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List and PGA TOUR membership for the first time.
- Sudarshan Yellamaraju went on to finish No. 19 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List and earned PGA TOUR membership for the first time.
- Four of the 11 players who finished T8 or higher at the 2025 Pinnacle Bank Championship finished in the top 20 of the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List and earned PGA TOUR membership for the 2026 season: Christo Lamprecht (Won), Sudarshan Yellamaraju (4th), Trace Crowe (5th), and Neal Shipley (T8).
