## PLAYERS TO WATCH



**Luke Gutschewski**, son of three-time Korn Ferry Tour winner and University of Nebraska alum Scott Gutschewski, will make his third start at the Pinnacle Bank Championship presented by Woodhouse. Gutschewski, an Omaha native, made his first Korn Ferry Tour start at the 2024 Pinnacle Bank Championship.



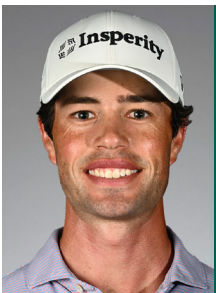
**Derek Hitchner** came out on top of a five-player playoff to win last week's Utah Championship presented by Zions Bank and Intermountain Health. Hitchner made birdie on the first hole (No. 18) of the sudden-death playoff to claim his first Korn Ferry Tour victory in his 18th career start. Hitchner earned Korn Ferry Tour membership for the first time with a No. 8 finish on the 2025 PGA TOUR Americas Points List.



**Ian Holt** reclaimed the top position on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List following a T9 finish at the Utah Championship. Holt, a two-time winner this season, held the No. 1 spot from January, after his win at The Bahamas Great Abaco Classic at the Abaco Club, until June when Doc Redman overtook the top position following the OccuNet Classic.



Following a runner-up finish at the Utah Championship, **Tommy Morrison** has logged top-10 finishes in all five of his starts to begin his professional career. Only Adrien Dumont de Chassart has more consecutive top-10 finishes to begin a Korn Ferry Tour career (six). With his victory at the Evans Scholars Invitational, Morrison became the fifth player to win on the Korn Ferry Tour in the same season they earned membership via PGA TOUR University performance benefits. Morrison finished No. 6 in the PGA TOUR University Class of 2026 after three and a half seasons at the University of Texas.



Fourth-year Korn Ferry Tour member **Cole Hammer** recorded his best career finish on Tour with his T2 at the Utah Championship after falling to Hitchner in the five-player playoff. Hammer, who rose to No. 20 on the Points List, was the only player to move inside the top 20 after last week's event. Hammer's previous best finish on the Korn Ferry Tour Points List was No. 65 (2024).

## TOURNAMENT NOTES

- The 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season -- the 36th season in Tour history -- continues with the Pinnacle Bank Championship presented by Woodhouse, the 19th tournament of the 25-event schedule.
- Field includes 11 PGA TOUR winners with 14 total victories, led by **Cameron Champ** with three TOUR wins.
- Field includes 65 Korn Ferry Tour winners with 89 total victories, led by four-time winner **Robby Shelton**, winner of the 2022 Pinnacle Bank Championship.
- Nine players in the field are in the top 200 in the Official World Golf Ranking: **Doc Redman** (No. 125), **Ross Steelman** (No. 132), **Ian Holt** (No. 145), **Cole Sherwood** (No. 154), **Davis Lamb** (No. 167), **Dylan Menante** (No. 168), **Tommy Morrison** (No. 172), **Jeremy Gandon** (No. 174), **Carson Young** (No. 186).

## 2026 KEY STORYLINES

- **Ian Holt** reclaimed the No. 1 position on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List from **Doc Redman**, following his T9 finish at last week's Utah Championship. Holt and Redman are the only multi-time winners on Tour this season. Should either win for a third time this season, they will earn an automatic promotion to the PGA TOUR via the Three-Victory Promotion. Matt McCarty (2024) was the last player to achieve the feat.
- Upon conclusion of the 25-event Korn Ferry Tour season, the top 20 players on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List will be awarded PGA TOUR cards (i.e. - membership) for the 2027 season. Additionally, the player who finishes No. 1 will earn exemptions for the 2027 PLAYERS Championship and 2027 U.S. Open.
- Of the current top 20 players on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, 16 would be earning PGA TOUR membership for the first time.
- There are 13 first-time winners this season: **Alistair Docherty, Zack Fischer, Derek Hitchner, Ian Holt, Davis Lamb, Dylan Menante, Tommy Morrison, Drew Nesbitt, James Nicholas, Alvaro Ortiz, Doc Redman, Cole Sherwood, and Ross Steelman.**
- Two players in the top 10 of the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List do not have a victory -- No. 5 **Hunter Eichhorn** and No. 9 **Blades Brown**. Eichhorn leads the Tour with eight top-10s. Only two players finished the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Season with at least eight top-10s: No. 1 **Johnny Keefer** (nine) and No. 4 **Neal Shipley** (eight).
- 19-year-old **Blades Brown**, who stands No. 12 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, earned Special Temporary Membership for the remainder of the 2026 PGA TOUR Season, granting him a position in the Priority Ranking and enabling him to accept an unlimited number of sponsor exemptions. Brown has two top-10s on TOUR this season (3rd/Puerto Rico Open, T9/ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic).
- Following the Compliance Solutions Championship, the third of four season-ending Korn Ferry Tour Finals events, the top 60 players on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List will qualify for the Korn Ferry Tour Championship presented by Virginia's Richmond Region at The Federal Club in Glen Allen, Virginia. Those 60 players will also earn full status for the 2027 Korn Ferry Tour Season.
