Robby Shelton (1st/-9)

- Four-time Korn Ferry Tour winner opens with a bogey-free 9-under 62, matching the 18-hole tournament scoring record (eighth occurrence)
- Winner of the 2022 Pinnacle Bank Championship presented by Woodhouse is making his fourth career start at the event; finished solo-third at the tournament in 2025
- Fourth 18-hole lead/co-lead of his Korn Ferry Tour career in what is his 112th start; 1-for-3 converting to victory (2019 Simmons Bank Open for the Snedeker Foundation)
- Earned full status for the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season with a No. 40 finish on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List
- Two-time Korn Ferry Tour graduate who earned PGA TOUR membership with multi-win Korn Ferry Tour seasons in 2019 and 2022
- Following a No. 87 finish in the 2023 FedExCup Fall standings, finished No. 141 in the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings, leaving him with conditional PGA TOUR status for the 2025 season
- Previously qualified for the 2020 FedExCup Playoffs as a PGA TOUR rookie, finishing No. 66 in the 2019-20 FedExCup standings
- Finished No. 2 in the 2017 Fortinet Cup standings on PGA TOUR Canada to earn Korn Ferry Tour membership for the 2018 season
- Played three seasons at University of Alabama (2013-16), garnering three consecutive All-America First Team honors and breaking Justin Thomas' school record with seven career victories

Additional Notes

- Two-time Korn Ferry Tour winner **Doc Redman** (2nd/-8), who stands No. 3 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, is bidding for his third victory of the 2026 campaign, which would grant him an immediate promotion to the PGA TOUR via the Three-Victory Promotion; Matt McCarty, winner of the 2024 Pinnacle Bank Championship, was the last player to achieve the feat (2024)
- **Nick Gabrelcik** (3rd/-7), who finished T8 at the 2025 Pinnacle Bank Championship, opens in 7-under 64, marking his second-lowest round of the season (63/Utah Championship/Round 4)
- **Christiaan Maas** (T4/-6), who finished No. 2 in the PGA TOUR University Class of 2026, holds his best first-round position in what is his sixth start on Tour (previous 18-hole high: T15/2026 Memorial Health Championship /finished T19)
- **John Marshall Butler** (T4/-6), who stands No. 57 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, holds his best first-round position since co-leading the season-opening The Bahamas Great Golf Classic at Atlantis Paradise Island (finished T44)
- **Mahanth Chirravuri** (T4/-6), who finished No. 8 in the 2026 PGA TOUR University Ranking, establishes a new high 18-hole position, opening in 6-under 65 (previous 18-hole high: T5/Club Car Championship/finished T22)
