Partial Third-Round Notes – Saturday, August 8, 2026

Suspension Summary: The third round was suspended due to inclement weather at 1:28 p.m. and did not resume, with 45 players needing to complete their third round. The third round will resume Sunday at 7 a.m. Final-round tee times are expected to run from approximately 11:15 a.m. through 1:15 p.m. in groups of three off the first and 10th tees.

Weather: Partly cloudy with afternoon showers. High of 87. Wind SSE 10-20 mph, gusts of 25 mph.

Frankie Harris (1st/-13 thru 6)

- Opened his third round with five consecutive birdies before play was suspended due to inclement weather; stands 5-under thru six holes of his third round
- Followed up an opening 3-under 68 with a 5-under 66 in the second round
- Finished No. 9 in the PGA TOUR University Class of 2026, granting him Korn Ferry Tour membership for the remainder of the 2026 season
- Owns three made cuts in his five career starts on Tour, with his best finish coming in the form of a T13 at the 2026 Memorial Health Championship presented by LRS
- Played three seasons at the University of South Carolina (2023-26) after transferring from Auburn University, where he spent two seasons (2021-23)
- In three seasons at the University of South Carolina, earned five individual victories (and was credited with a sixth win as a co-medalist) and garnered a 2026 All-America Second Team honor
- Broke the University of South Carolina school record for wins (six) and scoring average (70.37)
- Plays from Boca Raton, Florida

Additional Notes

- 36-hole leader **Robby Shelton** (2nd/-12 thru 1), winner of the 2022 Pinnacle Bank Championship presented by Woodhouse, made birdie on his first hole of the day before play was suspended

- **Doc Redman** (T3/-11 thru 8), who is a two-time winner on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Season, stands 4-under thru eight holes of his third round, highlighted by an eagle on the par-5 fourth and two birdies (Nos. 1, 7)
- **Derek Hitchner** (T12/-9), winner of last week's Utah Championship, made the 36-hole cut on the number and posted a bogey-free 7-under 64 in his third round
