Simmons Bank Open for the Snedeker Foundation

2026 marks the 10th playing of the event

TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- The Simmons Bank Open for the Snedeker Foundation enters its 10th season on the Korn Ferry Tour schedule, with Vanderbilt Legends Club serving as the host venue for a third consecutive year. The event became part of the season-ending Korn Ferry Tour Finals in 2023.
- The Simmons Bank Open for the Snedeker Foundation was recognized as the 2022 Tournament of the Year as part of the annual Korn Ferry Tour Tournament Awards.
- Each of the last eight winners of the Simmons Bank Open for the Snedeker Foundation earned PGA TOUR membership at season's end.
- Three champions of the Simmons Bank Open for the Snedeker Foundation became PGA TOUR winners -- Lanto Griffin (2017), Cam Davis (2018), and Grayson Murray (2023).

Cam Davis won the 2018 Simmons Bank Open for the Snedeker Foundation (pictured left), a victory which propelled him to PGA TOUR membership for the first time. Davis later earned his first PGA TOUR title at the 2021 Rocket Classic, the same event where he earned his second TOUR victory in 2024. With his win at the 2024 Rocket Classic, Davis became the first player since Corey Connors (2019 and 2023 Valero Texas Open) to earn his first two PGA TOUR titles at the same event.

- Zach Bauchou converted a one-stroke 54-hole lead into a two-stroke victory for his first Korn Ferry Tour title, which propelled him to a No. 11 finish on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List and PGA TOUR membership for the first time.
- With a winning total of 23-under 257, Bauchou broke the 72-hole tournament scoring record previously established by 2024 champion Paul Peterson (260).
- Austin Hitt recorded a career-high finish, leading to a No. 30 finish on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List and full status for the 2026 season.
- Ian Gilligan tied the 18-hole tournament scoring record with a 9-under 61 in the third round, springboarding him to a top-10 finish (T7). Gilligan recorded five top-10s in the first 10 events of the 2026 season.
