Extended forecast – With the cold front stalling out north of Nassau, rainfall amounts have been lowered tonight into Tuesday. Overall, shower activity near Paradise Island should remain infrequent with the more persistent activity north of the island. A low shower threat should persist into Wednesday with winds becoming southerly. A stronger front will push across the Bahamas on Thursday with showers becoming more widespread and heavier. Stronger westerly winds are also expected.
