Ross Steelman (1st/-18)

- Caps a round of 7-under 65 with a birdie at the par-4 18th, the toughest hole relative to par for both the third round and tournament; his birdie was one of only six made Saturday at No. 18
- Holds a two-stroke lead at 18-under 198, one stroke shy of the 54-hole tournament scoring record (197/Matt McCarty/2024)
- Holds his second 54-hole lead/co-lead on Tour, as he previously led the 2025 Blue Championship by three strokes through 54 holes (finished T4)
- Seeking first Korn Ferry Tour title and would be the 11th first-time winner this season
- Bidding to become the fifth consecutive 54-hole leader/co-leader to win (54-hole leaders/co-leaders are 11-for-15 overall converting to victory this season)
- Stands No. 23 on the 2026 Korn Ferry Tour Points List off the strength of a runner-up finish at the UNC Health Championship (lost playoff to Alvaro Ortiz)
- Earned full status for the 2026 season with a No. 32 finish on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List
- Finished No. 56 on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List in his first full season on Tour
- Finished No. 4 in the 2023 PGA TOUR University Ranking after two and a half seasons at University of Missouri (2019-21) and two seasons at Georgia Tech (2021-23); he notably finished T2 at the 2023 NCAA Championship

Additional Notes

- United States Air Force Academy graduate **Kyle Westmoreland** (T2/-16) cards the low round of the day, an 8-under 64 featuring eight birdies, one eagle, and back-to-back bogeys on Nos. 17 and 18
- **Tommy Morrison** (T2/-16), who finished No. 6 in the 2026 PGA TOUR University Ranking, stands T2 through 54 holes for the second consecutive event (Memorial Health Championship presented by LRS/finished T5)

- **Chris Korte** (T33/-9), a native of Littleton, Colorado who played collegiately at University of Denver, cards 4-under 68
