The Panamá Championship

2026 marks the 22nd playing of the event

TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- Established in 2004, The Panamá Championship is the seventh-oldest active event on the Korn Ferry Tour schedule.
- Club de Golf de Panamá has been one of the toughest courses on the Korn Ferry Tour since its addition to the schedule in 2004. Club de Golf de Panamá has finished as the No. 1 toughest course on Tour relative to par six times (2004, 2008, 2009, 2019, 2023, 2024), and was the No. 2 toughest course relative to par on Tour in 2025.
- Five past champions of the event became PGA TOUR winners: Jimmy Walker (2004), Carlos Ortiz (2014), Ryan Armour (2016), Andrew Putnam (2017), Davis Riley (2020).
- Prior to hosting an annual Korn Ferry Tour event, Club de Golf de Panamá hosted several editions of the Panamá Open, an event whose past champions included Roberto De Vicenzo (1952, 1953, 1971, 1973, 1974), Sam Snead (1954), Arnold Palmer (1956), and Doug Ford (1957).

- Josh Teater closed in 5-under 65 -- the lowest score of the final round by two strokes, and one of only nine sub-par scores recorded in the final round -- for his second Korn Ferry Tour title and first since the 2009 Utah Championship.
- Teater went 15 years, 4 months, 20 days between wins, marking the second-largest gap between wins in Korn Ferry Tour history. Teater won the 2025 Panama Championship at 45 years, 9 months, 27 days of age, making him the oldest Korn Ferry Tour winner since 46-year-old Scott Gutschewski in 2023.
- Dylan Wu went on to finish No. 69 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List in only eight starts, and he regained PGA TOUR membership in a playoff at Final Stage of 2025 PGA TOUR Q-Shool presented by Korn Ferry.
- Five of the top 10 finishers eventually finished in the top 20 of the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, earning PGA TOUR membership for the 2026 season: Johnny Keefer (T2), Hank Lebioda (5th), Austin Smotherman (T6), Neal Shipley (T9), Pierceson Coody (T9).
 - » Four of those players finished in the top six of the Korn Ferry Tour Points List: Keefer (No. 1), Smotherman (No. 3), Shipley (No. 4), Lebioda (No. 6).
