MEDICAL EXTENSIONS

Players in the field on medical extensions

Players on a Major or Minor Medical Extension who meet their top 100 points will move to a category called Top 100 (Medical), listed just below exempt players on the Priority Ranking (note: if injured in a season prior to 2025, players can move to the Top 100 Medical category by reaching their top 125 number, as that was the threshold for eligibility in the season in which they were injured; those players are noted by an asterisk *).

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

Stefano Mazzoli

Stefano Mazzoli officially joined the PGA TOUR as a member following his win at the Corales Puntacana Championship and is competing at the 3M Open out of the Tournament Winner category.

Because he was a non-member at the time of his victory at the Corales Puntacana Championship, he received a 1-year exemption (through 2027) and did not receive any FedExCup points. He is eligible to earn FedExCup points for the remainder of the season and any points he earns from this point forward will be reflected on the FedExCup Points List.

He will be eligible for the FedExCup Playoffs if he is in the top 70 on the FedExCup Points List through the Wyndham Championship.

Mazzoli is a PGA TOUR rookie this season. He would maintain his rookie eligibility next season if he plays in seven or fewer events this season and finishes outside the top 100 on the FedExCup Points List through the FedExCup Fall.

FedExCup Playoffs

There are three events remaining in the FedExCup Regular Season: 3M Open, Rocket Classic and Wyndham Championship.

The top 70 players in the FedExCup standings through the Wyndham Championship will qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs, which begin the following week at the FedEx St. Jude Championship. Players who qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs will secure their card for the 2027 season.
