Monday and Tuesday – A round of showers and thunderstorms are expected to arrive between 3-4am and depart between 6-7am Monday morning. There is an isolated chance for lingering activity through 8-9am before dry conditions become increasingly likely for the remainder of the day. Expect clouds will gradually decrease on Monday, becoming hazy sunshine Monday afternoon as wildfire smoke lingers across the region. Anticipate air quality will start off in the ‘Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups’ category on Monday before improving to the ‘Moderate’ AQI level Monday afternoon as westerly winds become gusty. Hazy sunshine and windy conditions will persist on Tuesday, with smoke and haze slated to increase late Tuesday into Tuesday night as winds turn north-northeasterly. **Sunrise: 5:44am / Sunset: 8:54pm**

Extended forecast – Smoke and haze is anticipated for a portion of Wednesday, but the degree of air quality degradation and the precise timing for improvement remains unclear and will be addressed in subsequent forecast updates. Southwesterly winds for the remainder of the week should bring improved air quality for the tournament rounds. Dry conditions are largely expected for much of the week, with isolated thunderstorm potential returning on Saturday night and Sunday. Temperatures will rise into the low 90s this weekend.
