Today – A weakening area of rain is approaching from the west and will provide a scattered coverage of light showers or drizzle for the start of the second round. Expect that these showers will become isolated by mid-morning with increasingly dry conditions towards midday. Breezy south-southwesterly winds are forecast, becoming sustained at 12-17 mph this afternoon along with gusts of 20-25 mph. High temperature: 83°F.

Extended forecast – An isolated shower or thunderstorm is possible between 3-7AM Saturday – with higher probabilities holding further north of TPC Twin Cities. Forecast confidence remains lower regarding the timing of any potential showers or thunderstorms on Sunday. At this time anticipate any rain or thunderstorm threat remains an isolated late Saturday night into Sunday morning. A few pop-up thunderstorms may return after 12PM Sunday with a scattered coverage of activity materializing after 7PM. The temperature will rise into the mid 90s this weekend. The heat index will reach 95-100°F Saturday and 100-105°F Sunday.
