Today –Patchy fog is possible around daybreak. Otherwise, partly cloudy skies and warm temperatures continue today with highs in the mid-80s. The ESE wind flow will push the sea breeze inland this afternoon prompting scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms to develop along it. Timing for these showers will likely be after 3pm with any shower activity dissipating this evening as we lose the heating of the day. Showers could produce brief heavy downpours as well.

Extended forecast – Southeasterly wind flow across the state will push the sea breeze inland each afternoon prompting scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms (20% chance for lightning) to develop after 2-3pm. Otherwise, it will be warm and humid with highs reaching the mid to upper 80s. Light wind during the morning will increase out of the southeast each afternoon to 10-15 with a few gusts to 20 mph.
