Rory McIlroy is making his first start of the 2026 PGA TOUR season and is seeking his second career back-to-back win in a season debut (2021 & '22 THE CJ CUP in South Carolina), as well as his third successful title defense on the PGA TOUR.

Ryan Fox is making his first start at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, where no player has won in their event debut since Brett Ogle in 1993. Fox won in his event debut at the 2024 ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic.

Scottie Scheffler has finished inside the Top 10 in 92.31% of Signature Events since 2024, with just one finish outside the Top 10. (T11, 2025 Arnold Palmer Invitational)

Hideki Matsuyama is coming off a playoff loss last week at the WM Phoenix Open and is seeking to become the first player from Japan to win the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.

Chris Gotterup can become the first player in 51 years to win three of the first five events of the PGA TOUR season (1975 Johnny Miller).

Wyndham Clark recorded the course record (60) at Pebble Beach Golf Links in the third round en route to his lone Signature Event win at the 2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.

Xander Schauffele has 10 PGA TOUR wins in his career, but none of those victories have come in his home state of California in 29 career starts. (Best Finish: T2 at 2021 Farmers Insurance Open)

Jordan Spieth is making his 14th start at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, the second most of any player in the field (Jason Day making 16th). He has finished inside the top 10 in 46.15% of his starts at this event, his fourth highest at an event in his PGA TOUR career.

Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory



Rory McIlroy earned his 27th PGA TOUR career title at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and first player since 2005 to pick up 27 career TOUR wins. McIlroy became the second player to win and make a hole-in-one at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am since 2016. He is the fifth international winner to win this event.

Broadcast Window Notes *(featured groups)*

Rory McIlroy has recorded three wins when making his season debut on the PGA TOUR, including his victory at this event last season. He has also won in eight consecutive PGA TOUR seasons from 2018 to 2025, the longest active streak on the PGA TOUR and the fourth-longest over the last 30 years. Over his PGA TOUR career, 54% of Rory McIlroy's total Strokes Gained has come Off-the-Tee. In his win last season at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, he led the field in SG: Off-the-Tee at +1.49, accounting for 42% of his total Strokes Gained.

Scottie Scheffler is seeking his third consecutive top 10 finish at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am entering the week, he is tied for the second Most Consecutive Top 10 Finishes (Active Streak) at this event. Scheffler is seeking his eighth consecutive top 4 finish, looking to tie Tiger Woods for the most on the PGA TOUR since 1983. He has historically performed well in Signature Events finishing inside the top 10 92.31% of the time since 2024, 45.64% better than the next best player (*min 5 starts*).

Hideki Matsuyama is looking to continue his impressive start having 3 top 15 Finishes in his first three starts, the third time in his PGA TOUR career to do so (2013 & 2017). Matsuyama has a Scrambling PCT of 67.15% since 2024, the second highest of any player in that span (*min 75 rds*). Matsuyama has ranked inside the top 10 in SG: Around the Green, Scrambling PCT, Sand Save PCT, and Proximity to Hole (ARG) in each of the last two seasons, the only player on the PGA TOUR to do so.

Chris Gotterup is coming off his fourth PGA TOUR win in just 71 starts, the fifth-fewest starts needed to reach four wins on the PGA TOUR since 2003. He became the first player since Ernie Els in 2003 to have 2+ Wins in the First Four Events of the PGA TOUR Season (*WON 2026 Sony Open in Hawaii & WM Phoenix Open*). Gotterup won in his event debut at the 2024 ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic, his Best Finish in an Event Debut, he is making his debut this week.
