Michael Thorbjornsen

Michael Thorbjornsen (No. 70 in the FedExCup Fall Points List) is unlikely to earn a spot in The Genesis Invitational when the field is filled to 72 players. However, Thorbjornsen is No. 43 in the Official World Golf Ranking and can qualify for The Genesis Invitational if he wins or moves into the top 30 in the OWGR after the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.

Marco Penge

Marco Penge qualified for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational as the leading finisher in the 2025 Race to Dubai, not otherwise exempt. The Højgaard twins earned those exemptions in 2024 (Nicolai) and 2025 (Rasmus).

Last man in the field

The last man in the field is Alex Smalley, No. 74 in the FedExCup Fall Points List. The field is filled to 80 players using the FedExCup Fall standings below No. 60.
