**Akshay Bhatia (T1/-15)**

- Cards a bogey-free 64, highlighted by an eagle on No. 14 at Spyglass Hill Golf Course; 2024 Rocket Classic was the only other time he has gone bogey-free thru 36 holes in his PGA TOUR career (595 days ago)
- Holds fourth 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (most recent: 2025 PLAYERS Championship/finished T3); is 1-for-3 on converting a 36-hole lead to a victory (2024 Valero Texas Open/Won, 2024 Rocket Classic/T2)
- 129 matches his career low 36-hole score (2024 Travelers Championship/finished T5)
- Making his 100th career start on TOUR and fourth start this season (MC/The American Express, MC/Farmers Insurance Open, T3/WM Phoenix Open)
- Marks third appearance at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (T30/2021, T22/2025)
- Two-time PGA TOUR winner (2023 Barracuda Championship, 2024 Valero Texas Open) finished No. 13 in the 2025 FedExCup, his best finish in three seasons on TOUR

**Ryo Hisatsune (T1/-15)**

- Cards a 5-under 67 in the second round after opening with a career-best 62 at Pebble Beach Golf Links
- Holds back-to-back 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2026 WM Phoenix Open/finished T10)
- 129 marks his career low 36-hole score on TOUR (previous best: 131, 2026 WM Phoenix Open/finished T10)
- Earned his best career finish on TOUR earlier this season with a runner-up at the Farmers Insurance Open
- Qualified via the Aon Swing 5 (No. 2) for entry into the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and next week's Genesis Invitational
- Marks second career start in a Signature Event (2025 RBC Heritage/T18)
- Making fifth start this season (MC/Sony Open in Hawaii, T44/The American Express, T2/Farmers Insurance Open, T10/WM Phoenix Open)
- Seeks to become the sixth different player from Japan to win on the PGA TOUR (Hideki Matsuyama, Shigeki Maruyama, Isao Aoki, Ryuji Imada, Satoshi Kodaira)
- Third-year TOUR member finished No. 95 in the 2025 FedExCup Fall standings to retain exempt status for 2026; first earned his card for the 2024 season via the 2023 DP World Tour Top 10 (No. 10)
- Was named the 2023 Sir Henry Cotton Rookie of the Year on the DP World Tour, the first player from Japan to win the award

**Miscellaneous Notes**

- **Rickie Fowler** (T3/-14) cards a second-round 64, setting his lowest score on Spyglass Hill Golf Course in five career rounds (previous best: 67, 2024/R1/finished T47); 8-under matches Bhatia with low round of the day at Spyglass Hill

- Five-time TOUR winner **Sam Burns** (T3/-14) cards a 5-under 67 in the second round; owns two top-25 finishes in three appearances at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (10<sup>th</sup>/2024, T22/2025)
- At 20-under, **Keegan Bradley**/Mary Meeker win the Pro-Am portion of the competition
- **Harris English** (T22/-8) cards a bogey-free 9-under 63 to set low round of the day on Pebble Beach Golf Links
