Collin Morikawa (Winner/-22)

- Earns seventh PGA TOUR victory in his 145th start at age of 29 years, 9 days
- Wins in his 46th PGA TOUR start since his last victory at the 2023 Baycurrent Classic (span of 848 days)
- PGA TOUR wins (7): 2019 Barracuda Championship, 2020 Workday Charity Open, 2020 PGA Championship, 2021 WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession, 2021 The Open Championship, 2023 Baycurrent Classic, 2026 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am
- Third TOUR victory in California (2019 Barracuda Championship, 2020 PGA Championship at TPC Harding Park)
- First win in a Signature Event
- Earns 700 FedExCup points and moves to No. 3 in the FedExCup standings
- Moves from No. 19 to No. 5 in the Official World Golf Ranking
- 22-under matches the lowest score relative to par by a winner in tournament history (Brandt Snedeker/2015)
- Entered the final round two strokes back of 54-hole leader Akshay Bhatia; of his six TOUR titles in standard stroke-play events, has won five times on TOUR when trailing through 54 holes (led at the 2021 WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession)
- Led the field this week in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (12.600), Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (9.681)
- Win comes in his third start at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (T14/2024, T17/2025, Won/2026); has shot under par in all 11 rounds at the event
- Highlights of the week include hitting all 18 greens in regulation during a third-round 62 and becoming the seventh player since 1985 to do so at Pebble Beach Golf Links during the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am

Miscellaneous Notes

- Seeking his second PGA TOUR victory (2025 Texas Children's Houston Open), **Min Woo Lee** (T2/-21) earns third runner-up finish in his 71st start (2024 Rocket Classic, 2024 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches)
- Making his fourth start at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, four-time PGA TOUR winner **Sepp Straka** (T2/-21) records fourth runner-up finish and first since the 2023 Open Championship
- World No. 1 **Scottie Scheffler** (T4/-20) cards a final round 9-under 63, highlighted by three eagles (Nos. 2, 6, 18), becoming the first player to record three eagles in a round at Pebble Beach Golf Links during the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (since 1983); records eighth consecutive top-five and 18th consecutive top-10 on TOUR

Most consecutive top-five finishes on PGA TOUR since 1983:

- Tiger Woods: 11 (2007 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational - 2008 U.S. Open)
- Tiger Woods: 8 (2006 BMW Championship - 2007 Farmers Insurance Open)
- Scheffler: 8 (2025 Open Championship-active)

- Making his season debut, 2025 FedExCup Champion **Tommy Fleetwood** (T4/-20) earns 46th top-10 on TOUR
- Defending champion **Rory McIlroy** (T14/-17) records an 8-under 64 in the final round, his 12th career final round of 64 or better on the PGA TOUR; holds third-most final rounds of 64 or better on TOUR since 2010 (Webb Simpson/14, Brian Harman/13)
