Extended forecast – Cloud cover will increase again tonight. These clouds could lower to a fog for a time overnight, but this should lift by sunrise Saturday. Cloud cover remains thick on Saturday with increasing southerly winds during the afternoon. The next storm system will approach on Sunday, however the most substantial impacts likely hold off until Sunday night and Monday. Regardless, some shower activity is still possible on Sunday with light rainfall amounts expected. Brisk southerly winds are becoming increasingly likely with gusts upwards of 30 mph.
