Today – Intervals of showers to move across the Monterey Peninsula much of the day. These showers will eventually transition to a heavier/steadier rain later tonight. A rumble of thunder could also occur. The bigger concern will be winds with sustained southerlies over 25 mph and gusts near 40 mph. These winds could develop very abruptly between 11am-1pm with the higher end gusts (over 35 mph) sporadic at times. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.25". **Sunrise: 6:55am / Sunset: 5:48pm**

Tomorrow – Low pressure will track very close to the Monterey Peninsula on Monday with widespread steady/heavy rain ongoing Monday morning. Steadier rains should eventually give way to scattered showers during the afternoon. A low threat for lightning exists with this activity. Wind gusts over 30 mph will also be possible Monday afternoon, however this is very dependent on the exact track of the low. Rainfall: 1.00-2.00". **Sunrise: 6:55am / Sunset: 5:48pm**
