Extended forecast– Slightly drier air will make for more comfortable conditions Tuesday. However, mostly cloudy skies and patchy fog will be possible to start the day. Otherwise, a ridge of high pressure will provide dry conditions through Wednesday before weakening and allowing warmer and more humid conditions to return Thursday through the rest of the week. This will likely lead to the chance for scattered showers and thunderstorms to develop each afternoon through the weekend with highs generally in the mid-80s to upper 80s.
