Wyndham Clark (1st/-12)

- Marks the first time in his career (210th start) without a bogey through 36 holes; only player in the field without a bogey
- Seventh 36-hole lead/co-lead in individual stroke-play events; 2-for-6 converting (2023 Truist Championship, 2026 U.S. Open)
- Seeking to become the first player to win the U.S. Open and BMW Championship in the same season since Dustin Johnson (2016)
- PGA TOUR wins (5): 2023 Truist Championship, 2023 U.S. Open, 2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, 2026 CJ CUP Byron Nelson, 2026 U.S. Open
- Leads the field in Scrambling (5/5) and Sand Saves (3/3; T1)
- Projected No. 3 in the FedExCup standings in attempt to advance to the TOUR Championship for the third time (2023/3rd, 2024/8th)
- Best finish in four prior starts at the BMW Championship: T13/2024

Gary Woodland (2nd/-11)

- Leads the field in three Strokes Gained categories: Off the Tee (2.455), Tee to Green (7.514), Approach the Green (4.484)
- PGA TOUR wins (5): 2011 Valspar Championship, 2013 Reno-Tahoe Open, 2018 WM Phoenix Open, 2019 U.S. Open, 2026 Texas Children's Houston Open
- Projected No. 17 in the FedExCup standings in attempt to advance to the TOUR Championship for the first time since 2019
- Best finish in nine prior starts at the BMW Championship: T12/2018
- One of 17 players in this week's field who competed in the 2018 PGA Championship held at Bellerive CC (finished T6)

Additional notes

- Second-round standings for the five first-round co-leaders: **Wyndham Clark** (1st/-12), **Gary Woodland** (2nd/-11), **J.J. Spaun** (3rd/-10), **Chris Gotterup** (T4/-9), **Rory McIlroy** (T8/-7)
- 2025 U.S. Open champion **J.J. Spaun** (3rd/-10) cards a 4-under 66 on his 36th birthday; leads the field with 14 birdies
- In search of his fourth victory this season, **Chris Gotterup** (T4/-9) trails by three following a 3-under 67
- **Sungjae Im** (T4/-9) entered the week No. 40 in the FedExCup standings and is currently projected No. 28; has advanced to the TOUR Championship in each of his first seven seasons on TOUR
- Other notable scores:
 - Three-time FedExCup champion and 2012 BMW Championship winner **Rory McIlroy** (T8/-7)
 - World No. 1 and defending champion **Scottie Scheffler** (T25/-3)
 - Reigning FedExCup Champion **Tommy Fleetwood** (T30/-2)

FedExCup Playoffs:

- Following this week's BMW Championship, the top 30 players will advance to next week's TOUR Championship
- Players projected to move into the top 30:
 - **Gary Woodland** (2nd); from No. 31 to No. 17
 - **Sungjae Im** (T4); from No. 40 to No. 28
 - **Michael Thorbjornsen** (T6); from No. 41 to No. 30
- Players projected to fall out of the top 30:
 - **Kurt Kitayama** (T37); from No. 28 to No. 32
 - **Rickie Fowler** (T37); from No. 30 to No. 33
 - **Bud Cauley** (47th); from No. 29 to No. 34
