Sunday through Tuesday – Isolated pop-up showers and thunderstorms will be a possibility this afternoon through 6pm. After 6-7pm and through 11pm-midnight expect a widespread coverage of showers and thunderstorms. A few of these thunderstorms may produce **strong to severe wind gusts of 50-60 mph** tonight. Isolated showers and weak thunderstorms may linger into early Monday with dry conditions returning by daybreak. Dry conditions will be in place for the remainder of Monday and again on Tuesday. The next potential for showers and thunderstorms arrives overnight Tuesday. **Sunrise: 6:18am / Sunset: 7:53pm**

Extended forecast – Showers and thunderstorms are expected to move in from the north overnight Tuesday into Wednesday morning out ahead of a cold front. Expect this activity will become more scattered by midday with chances persisting into Wednesday afternoon. Another round of thunderstorms is expected overnight Wednesday into Thursday morning as the frontal boundary moves through the region. Forecast confidence is medium beyond Thursday, but presently expect isolated to a few thunderstorms will be possible both Thursday night/early Friday and again Friday night/early Saturday as a couple weak disturbances move overhead. Dry conditions return Sunday.
