Scottie Scheffler

- World No. 1 will make ninth start of the season and debut at Trump National Doral (Blue Monster)
- Enters the week after finishing runner-up in back-to-back starts on TOUR for the first time in his career (Masters Tournament, RBC Heritage)
- With a win, would become the second player this season to finish runner-up and then win the next week (Matt Fitzpatrick: 2nd/THE PLAYERS Championship, Won/Valspar Championship)
- Earned 20th PGA TOUR victory earlier this season at The American Express
- Has finished T3 or better 45 times in 158 starts on TOUR (28.5%); win (20), 2nd (12), 3rd (13)
- Has 29 straight top-25 finishes on TOUR; last finish outside the top 25: 2024 BMW Championship (T33)
- 2024 FedExCup champion holds the TOUR's current longest streak of consecutive made cuts (72)

Justin Rose

- Won the 2012 WGC-Cadillac Championship played at Trump National Doral
- Making eighth start of the season and first since finishing T3 at the Masters Tournament
- 13-time PGA TOUR winner with one win this season (Farmers Insurance Open)
- Won the 2026 Farmers Insurance Open by seven strokes, the largest margin of victory on TOUR this season
- 45-year-old reached No. 3 in the Official World Golf Ranking with his victory at Torrey Pines, making him the second-oldest player in the top-three of the OWGR (Vijay Singh/45 years, 8 months)

Adam Scott

- Winner of the 2016 WGC-Cadillac Championship, the most recent event held at Trump National Doral prior to this week
- Qualified by virtue of his position in the Aon Next 10 through the Zurich Classic of New Orleans (No. 8)
- Best finish in eight starts this season is solo fourth at The Genesis Invitational, his first top-10 on TOUR since the 2024 TOUR Championship
- 45-year-old is exempt through the 2026 PGA TOUR Season via his top-30 finish (No. 4) in the 2024 FedExCup standings

Jhonattan Vegas

- Venezuela native has two top-25 finishes in nine starts this season (T18/Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, T14/Texas Children's Houston Open)
- Four-time PGA TOUR winner's most recent victory came at the 2024 3M Open
- Younger brother, Julio Vegas, is a teaching professional at Trump National Doral and was a member of the Texas Longhorns 2012 NCAA Championship winning team

Alex Fitzpatrick

- Earned his first PGA TOUR victory at last week's Zurich Classic of New Orleans (with brother and World No. 3 Matt Fitzpatrick) in his 11th start on TOUR
- The 27-year-old became the first non-member and sponsor exemption to win on TOUR since Michael Brennan (2025 Bank of Utah Championship)
- With the win, earned his PGA TOUR card through 2028 along with exemptions into this week and the 2026 PGA Championship, 2026 Truist Championship, 2026 Memorial Tournament presented by Workday, 2026 Travelers Championship and 2027 PLAYERS Championship

- Third first-time winner in 16 events this season: Jacob Bridgeman (The Genesis Invitational), Ricky Castillo (Puerto Rico Open)
- Owns two additional professional victories, including his first win on the DP World Tour at the 2026 Hero Indian Open, which came one week after Matt's Valspar Championship win (other: 2023 British Challenge on the HotelPlanner Tour)

Cadillac Championship notes:

- Following a 10-year hiatus, the TOUR returns to Miami and the City of Doral for the inaugural Cadillac Championship (the event will not carry the history of previous PGA TOUR events contested at Doral)
- The Cadillac Championship will mark the 56th playing of a TOUR event at the famed Blue Monster having previously hosted the TOUR consecutively from 1962 to 2016
- The Blue Monster is one of nine current venues to appear on the 2026 TOUR schedule with more than half a century of history, joining Waialae Country Club, Torrey Pines Golf Course, Pebble Beach Golf Links, The Riviera Country Club, Augusta National Golf Club, Harbour Town Golf Links, Colonial Country Club and Muirfield Village Golf Club
- Fifth of eight Signature Events of the season and includes 37 of the top 50 players in the Official World Golf Ranking, headlined by seven in the top 10: Scottie Scheffler (No. 1), Cameron Young (No. 4), Justin Rose (No. 5), Collin Morikawa (No. 6), Tommy Fleetwood (No. 7), Russell Henley (No. 8), J.J. Spaun (No. 10).
- Of the 72 players in the field at the Cadillac Championship, 18 have played in previous PGA TOUR events held at Trump National Doral, including two players with wins at the venue: Daniel Berger, Keegan Bradley, Jason Day, Harris English, Tommy Fleetwood, Rickie Fowler, Lucas Glover, Russell Henley, David Lipsky, Shane Lowry, Hideki Matsuyama, Alex Noren, Justin Rose (2012 WGC-Cadillac Championship winner), Adam Scott (2016 WGC-Cadillac Championship winner), Jordan Spieth, Justin Thomas, Jhonattan Vegas, Gary Woodland
- Additional field features:
 - 45 of the top 50 in the 2026 FedExCup standings, led by No. 2 **Scottie Scheffler**
 - 57 of the 72 players in the field have won on TOUR, led by **Scottie Scheffler** (20) and **Justin Thomas** (16)
 - Sponsor exemptions (4): **Joel Dahmen, Max Greyserman, Max Homa, Keith Mitchell**

Aon Next 10 and Swing 5

- The Aon Swing 5 is made up of the five players, not otherwise exempt, who earned the most FedExCup points in the Puerto Rico Open, Valspar Championship, Texas Children's Houston Open, Valero Texas Open and the Zurich Classic of New Orleans: **Ricky Castillo, David Lipsky, Matt Wallace, Alex Smalley, Chandler Blanchet**

PGA TOUR season notes

- **First-Time Winners:** Through 16 events of the 2026 PGA TOUR Season, there have only been three first-time TOUR winners (Jacob Bridgeman/The Genesis Invitational, Ricky Castillo/Puerto Rico Open, Alex Fitzpatrick/Zurich Classic of New Orleans)
- **Close calls:** With Matt and Alex Fitzpatrick's one-stroke victory at last week's Zurich Classic of New Orleans, 11 of the last 13 events on TOUR have been decided by one stroke or in a playoff
