Chris Gotterup is the only player on the PGA TOUR this season to rank inside the Top 10 in Driving Dist. – All Drives (6th), SG: Off the Tee (T8), Club Head Speed (9th), & SG: Tee-to-Green (9th)

Hideki Matsuyama seeking his third win at a Signature Events since 2024 (2024 The Genesis Invit. & 2025 The Sentry), he is one of three players to have multiple Signature Event wins.

Viktor Hovland ranks 4th in Putting from > 25' on the PGA TOUR this season (10.87%), on track to be his highest percentage of putts made greater than 25' in his PGA TOUR career.

Tommy Fleetwood has 7 Top 10 finishes at Signature Events without a win since 2024, the most of any player in that span

Sam Burns is driving the ball 300-320 yards 38.55% of the time, the fourth most of any player on the PGA TOUR this season and his highest percentage at this margin of distance in his PGA TOUR career.

Rickie Fowler has a scoring average of 68.89 before the cut this season, the 7th lowest of any player on the PGA TOUR this season and the lowest of Fowler's PGA TOUR career.

Scottie Scheffler averages 76 days between wins the Shortest Average Days Between Wins on the PGA TOUR All-Time (of the 119 players with 10 or more PGA TOUR wins).

Cameron Young has a Top 5 percentage of 24.24% on the PGA TOUR the last two seasons the fourth best of any player in that span (min 30 rds)

Jordan Spieth has made 15 consecutive starts without a Top 10 Finish, tied for his second longest streak in his PGA TOUR career

Justin Thomas in his 17 career starts at Signature Events since 2024 he has finished inside the Top 5 23.53% of the time, 9.74% more than in Non-Signature Events in that span (13.79%)

Justin Rose the 2012 WGC – Workday Championship champion is one of two past champions at Trump National Doral – Blue Monster Course in the field this week (2016 WGC – Workday Championship Adam Scott

Adam Scott has made 11 career starts including one win at Trump National Doral – Blue Monster Course (*entering the week*) the most starts of any player in the field this week

Winner Analysis

Approach the Green

Since 2004, eight of the last 13 winners in a stroke play event at Trump National Doral (Blue Monster) ranked inside the top 4 for the week in Greens in Regulation Percentage, tied for the second most of any course on the PGA TOUR from 2004-2016 (last year event played here). Hitting greens allowed the past champions to gain multiple strokes per round approaching the green, with six of the last 13 winners leading the field en route to victory, tied for the most winners to lead in this category on a course in the PGA TOUR ShotLink era.

Since 2004 the winners have averaged a greens in regulation percentage of 70.94% while converting 41.27% of greens hit into birdies or better. The winners have out played the rest of the field on every par hitting 65% or more greens in all three, while the rest of the field was under 60% on par 3's and 4's and 9.40% worse on par 5's.

From 2004 to 2016 winners at Trump National Doral – Blue Monster averaged +1.64 strokes gained approaching the green. The fifth highest average of any winners on a PGA TOUR course in that 12 year span. Four winners averaged 2+ strokes approaching the green, while only three averaged gaining under one strokes.

Broadcast Window Notes - Featured Groups

Chris Gotterup has played 55.56% of his rounds in the 60s on the weekend this season compared to 45% of his rounds during the week. Is ranked inside the Top 10 in four different Off the Tee categories (Driving Distance – All Drives, SG: Off-the-Tee, Club Head Speed & SG: Tee-to-Green) this season, the only player ranked inside the top 10 in each category. Gotterup is seeking his best finish in a Signature Event since finishing T18 earlier this season at the Arnold Palmer Invitational.

Sam Burns is making his 21st career start in a Signature Event on the PGA TOUR, finishing inside the top 10 in four of his 20 previous starts. Entering this week Burns is ranked 11th in Strokes Gained: Putting, his sixth season inside the top 15 in this category on the PGA TOUR since 2020, the most of any other player. Burns has made improvements on the Greens from the 10-15' range going from T99 in 2023 to 38th in 2024 to 7th in 2025 and 1st this season.
