Sunday Forecast – A cold front is forecast to stall just south of Miami during the morning, but a tropical and unstable air mass will remain over the region. A weakening line of showers and a few thunderstorms will likely move through the area between 5AM-8AM with a lull in the precipitation expected late morning. Scattered showers and thunderstorms are forecast to redevelop after 2pm and continue into the evening hours. Storms will produce gusty winds and heavy rainfall with amounts averaging 0.70"-1.00" with higher amounts up to 2" locally.
