Through 2028

If already exempt thru 2028, add one year to exemption (max thru 2031)

Exemptions to Majors and THE PLAYERS

- 2026 U.S. Open if second win in 500+ FedExCup point events since the 2025 U.S. Open
- 2027 PLAYERS Championship
- 2027 Masters Tournament
- 2027 PGA Championship

Exemptions to Signature Events

- 2026 Memorial Tournament presented by Workday
- 2026 Travelers Championship

While the winner does not receive direct exemptions to the following events, he will improve his chances of qualifying for the following events:

- 2026 U.S. Open Top 60 Official World Golf Ranking (June 15, 2026)
- 2026 FedEx St. Jude Championship Top 70 FedExCup Points List through Wyndham Championship
- 2026 BMW Championship Top 50 FedExCup Points List through FedEx St. Jude Championship
- 2026 TOUR Championship Top 30 FedExCup Points List through BMW Championship

MEDICAL EXTENSIONS

Players in the field on medical extensions

Players on a Major or Minor Medical Extension who meet their top 100 points will move to a category called Top 100 (Medical), listed just below exempt players on the Priority Ranking (note: if injured in a season prior to 2025, players can move to the Top 100 Medical category by reaching their top 125 number, as that was the threshold for eligibility in the season in which they were injured; those players are noted by an asterisk *).

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

Aon Swing 5/Aon Next 10

The Charles Schwab Challenge is the final tournament that counts towards the Aon Swing 5 and Aon Next 10 for the Memorial Tournament.

The Aon Swing 5 for the Travelers Championship is based on points earned in the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic, THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson, Charles Schwab Challenge and RBC Canadian Open, while the Aon Next 10 will be determined through the U.S. Open.

Charles Schwab Challenge eligibility changes

The following adjustments were made to the eligibility for the Charles Schwab Challenge in conjunction with the adjustments to field sizes and eligibility on TOUR this season:

- » Replaced exempt category of top 125 in the prior season's FedExCup Points List with top 100
- » Included exempt members from DP World Tour, Korn Ferry Tour, Q-School and PGA TOUR University categories
- » Removed exemptions for winners prior to 2000 who were within the top 150 of the prior season's FedExCup Points List
- » Removed top-15 finishers (including non-members) from the prior season's event
