**Playoff**

- 15<sup>th</sup> playoff at Charles Schwab Challenge in tournament history
- Most recent playoff: 2023 (Emiliano Grillo def. Adam Schenk)
- Fourth playoff on TOUR this season (WM Phoenix Open/Chris Gotterup def. Hideki Matsuyama, Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard/Akshay Bhatia def. Daniel Berger, RBC Heritage/Matt Fitzpatrick def. Scottie Scheffler)
- Updated PGA TOUR playoff records:
  - Russell Henley: 2-1
  - Eric Cole: 0-2

**Russell Henley (Won/-12)**

- Defeats Eric Cole in a playoff to win his sixth PGA TOUR title in his 321st start at the age of 37 years, 1 month, 19 days
- Now improves to 2-1 in playoffs
  - 2014 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches (defeated Russell Knox, Rory McIlroy, Ryan Palmer)
  - 2022 Sony Open in Hawaii (lost to Hideki Matsuyama)
  - 2026 Charles Schwab Challenge (defeated Eric Cole)
- PGA TOUR wins (6): 2013 Sony Open in Hawaii, 2014 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches, 2017 Texas Children's Houston Open, 2022 World Wide Technology Championship, 2025 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, 2026 Charles Schwab Challenge
- Entered the final round three shots back from the lead, birdied his final three holes to tie the lead and force a playoff
- Becomes the second winner of the Charles Schwab Challenge to make birdie or better on the final three holes (other: Jordan Spieth/2016)
- Wins 500 FedExCup points and moves from No. 26 to No. 11 in the FedExCup standings
- Three starts at the Charles Schwab Challenge: T58/2018, T16/2023, Won/2026
- In 12 starts this season, owns four top-10 finishes, highlighted by a victory at the Charles Schwab Challenge and a T3 finish at the Masters Tournament

**Additional Player Notes**

- 54-hole leader **Eric Cole** (P2/-12) falls to Henley in a playoff; owns three runner-up finishes on TOUR: 2023 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches (lost in a playoff to Chris Kirk), 2023 Baycurrent Classic, 2026 Charles Schwab Challenge
- **Ben Griffin** (T3/-11) finishes one back in bid to join Ben Hogan (1946-47, 1952-53) as the only back-to-back winners; matches his best finish this season (other: 3<sup>rd</sup>/Cadillac Championship)
- Making first start since finishing T2 at the PGA Championship, **Alex Smalley** (T3/-11) earns his seventh straight top-25 finish
- Dallas, Texas native **Mac Meissner** (T3/-11) earns his second top-10 finish in his third start at the Charles Schwab Challenge (T5/2024, T28/2025, T3/2026); sitting at No. 4 in the Aon Swing 5, earns a spot in next week's Memorial Tournament presented by Workday
