## Featured Groups *(click for active links)*

**Ludvig Åberg** is making his event debut at the Charles Schwab Challenge this week, Åberg has four runner-up finishes in event debuts the second most of any player on the PGA TOUR since 2022 (6, Cameron Young).

**Gary Woodland** is 18-under par on the Par 5's at this event since 2020, tied for the best Par 5 Performance of any player in that span.

**J.J. Spaun** is seeking to become the fourth player to earn 3+ wins in the state of Texas Since 2006, has earned both of his wins in Texas at the Valero Texas Open (2022 & '26).

**Ben Griffin** is making his title defense this week from his win last season. Ben Hogan is the only player to successfully defend their title at this event (1946 & 1947 / 1952 & 1953).

**Tom Hoge** is making his 332<sup>nd</sup> career start this week and his seeking his 2<sup>nd</sup> PGA TOUR win. His best finish in his previous nine starts at this event is T17 (2016 & 2024).

**Rickie Fowler** has finished inside the top 10 in 3 of his last 4 starts, marking 4 total on the season, one more than he had the entire 2025 season.

**Brandt Snedeker** has Sand Save Percentage of 67.72% on the PGA TOUR the last two seasons, the highest of any player in that span (min 60 rds).

**Tony Finau** has played his last four rounds all in the 60's and his last 29 holes without a bogey or worse, currently holds the second longest active streak without a bogey or worse on the PGA TOUR this season.

**Akshay Bhatia** In the last three seasons Bhatia has improved his par 4 scoring each year moving from T84 to T3 in scoring average from 2024 to this season.

**Russell Henley** leads the TOUR in Scrambling this season and on track for his highest percentage in a season in his PGA TOUR Career.

**Justin Thomas** has won 5.95% of his starts in his PGA TOUR career, the highest winning percentage of any player in the field this week.

**Sungjae Im** is making his 18<sup>th</sup> starts in the state of Texas, in his previous 17 starts he has not won marking his second most starts in a state without a win in his PGA TOUR Career.

**Keegan Bradley** is making his 32<sup>nd</sup> start in Texas in his PGA TOUR Career, where he has finished inside the top 10 in 25.81% of his starts including a win at the 2011 THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson.

**Brian Harman** has made 13 starts at this event without a win, tied for the sixth most of any player in the field entering the week.

**Ryan Gerard** has averaged 0.49 strokes on approach to the green over the last two seasons, the fourth most of any player in the field with a min of 50 measured rounds played.

**Hideki Matsuyama** is making his 300<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR career start this week, the last player to win on their 300<sup>th</sup> career start was Ben Crane at the 2014 FedEx St. Jude Classic.

**Robert MacIntyre** is making his third career start at the Charles Schwab Challenge, with his best finish being T6 in 2025, the best by any player from Scotland at this event.

**Alex Smalley** is making his 142<sup>nd</sup> PGA TOUR career start and is seeking his first career win. Smalley has finished inside the Top 2 in 2 of his last 4 events, while only finishing inside the top 2 twice in his 137 previous starts.

### Defending Champion ShotLink Analysis

Ben Griffin earned his second career win and his first individual stroke play win at the 2025 Charles Schwab Challenge. Griffin earned 500 FedExCup points and moved from 21<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup>, marking the first week of his PGA TOUR career inside the Top 10 of the FedExCup Standings.

Griffin gained a total of 6.81 strokes in the second round, his third most strokes gained in 327 ShotLink measured rounds on the PGA TOUR. He also gained 3.95 strokes approaching the green, his second best approach performance of his PGA TOUR career.

The top five FedExCup points earners in the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic, THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson, and the Charles Schwab Challenge will earn spots in the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday via the Aon Swing 5. (As part of the Returning Member Program, should Brooks Koepka finish in the top five of the Aon Swing 5 standings, the No. 6 player will also gain access into the next Signature Event).

#### Putting Analysis

Since 2016, nine out of the last 10 winners at the Charles Schwab Challenge ranked inside the top 10 in Strokes Gained: Putting, tied for the most of any other event in that span. In the last 10 years, 40.49% of all strokes gained by winners at this event came from the putting surface, the most of any other strokes gained category. In total the winners gained +60.11 strokes putting, the fifth most of winners in an event on the PGA TOUR since 2016.
