**Today** – There is a few t-storms 60 miles to the NW of Fort Worth that may bring a passing shower around 9am if it holds together. Otherwise, partly cloudy skies and warm temperatures can be expected today with highs in the mid to upper 80s. An isolated thunderstorm could develop during the afternoon, but most locations will remain dry today. The wind will remain light and average 4-8 mph.

**Extended forecast**– A weak ridge of high pressure will provide partly cloudy skies and hot temperatures over the next few days with highs in the low 90s. A weak disturbance may produce isolated thunderstorms Saturday night into early Sunday morning. Otherwise, the final round will be dry with highs in the low 90s. The next chance for thunderstorms will be Monday night into Tuesday as the next wave of energy arrives from the west.
