Today –Patchy fog will be possible around daybreak. Otherwise, partly cloudy, warm and humid conditions are forecast today with highs reaching the low to mid-80s this afternoon. Higher instability combined with the sea breeze moving onshore will produce scattered showers and a few thunderstorms after 3pm and continuing into the evening hours. Light wind will shift out of the southeast and increase to 10-15 gusting to 20 mph during the afternoon as well.

Extended forecast – Warm and humid conditions continue Saturday as a front is expected to move slowly southward across Florida, interacting with upper-level energy passing over the region. This will bring a good chance for showers and thunderstorms, especially Saturday afternoon into Saturday night. Storms could be strong with gusty wind, hail and heavy rainfall. The front is forecast to slowly shift south of the area Sunday, decreasing the chances for showers and providing slightly cooler and less humid conditions.
