Today – A passing shower or isolated thunderstorm cannot be ruled out this morning. Otherwise, mostly cloudy skies can be expected with temperatures in the 70s. Scattered showers and thunderstorms are forecast to develop after 1pm and become more numerous as we go through the rest of the afternoon as a cold front slowly moves south through Central Florida. Storms could be strong with gusty wind, hail and heavy rainfall.

Sunday Forecast – The cold front will settle south of West Palm Beach and stall across Southern Florida by the end of the day. This will allow slightly cooler and less humid air to move into the area as we go through the day. Cannot rule out a passing shower or isolated thunderstorm as the sea breeze moves inland during the afternoon, but the higher chances for showers or thunderstorms will be south of West Palm Beach closer to the front.
