Through 2027

*Note: non-members would **not** receive 300 FedExCup pts.*

MEDICAL EXTENSIONS

Players in the field on medical extensions

Players on a Major or Minor Medical Extension who meet their top 100 points will move to a category called Top 100 (Medical), listed just below exempt players on the Priority Ranking (note: if injured in a season prior to 2025, players can move to the Top 100 Medical category by reaching their top 125 number, as that was the threshold for eligibility in the season in which they were injured; those players are noted by an asterisk *).

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

Field makeup

- » 50 players from DP World Tour
- » Remainder from PGA TOUR Priority Ranking

Non-member regulations

If a non-member or Special Temporary Member wins the Corales Puntacana Championship, he receives:

- » **One-year exemption** through 2027 (rather than two through 2028)
- » **No FedExCup points** (any non-member FedExCup points earned in previous events this season would be converted to the FedExCup points list)
- » **No Official Money** (receives winner's share in unofficial money)

If a non-member finishes in the top 10 at the Corales Puntacana Championship, he would not earn a spot in the 3M Open.
