- The 54-hole leader(s)/co-leader(s) on TOUR have gone on to win 10 of 28 events this season
- The 54-hole leader/co-leader at the Corales Puntacana Championship has won three of the last eight years (most recent: Joel Dahmen/2021)

Todd Clements (1st/-18)

- 18- and 36-hole leader/co-leader cards a 5-under 67 to hold a two-stroke lead after the third round
- Holds 54-hole lead/co-lead for first time on TOUR (previous best 54-hole position: T27/2025 Barracuda Championship/finished 3rd)
- 198 marks career-low 54-hole score on TOUR (previous best: 204/2024 Barracuda Championship/finished T33)
- Making second start on TOUR this season (ISCO Championship/MC); owns five top-25 finishes on the DP World Tour this season (best: T11/DS Automobiles 83° Open d'Italia)
- Making tournament debut at the Corales Puntacana Championship
- Best finish on TOUR: 3rd/2025 Barracuda Championship
- Seeks first PGA TOUR title in his seventh career start at the age of 29 years, 10 months, 21 days
- Englishman owns one title on the DP World Tour: 2023 D+D Real Czech Masters
- Enters the week at No. 115 in the DP World Tour Race to Dubai Rankings
- With a win, would become the sixth first-time winner on TOUR this season (most recent: Bud Cauley/RBC Canadian Open) and fourth player to earn their first win at the Corales Puntacana Championship (most recent: Matt Wallace/2023)
- With a win, would become the 10th international winner on TOUR this season and second player from England to win the Corales Puntacana Championship (other: Matt Wallace/2023)
- With a win, would receive a PGA TOUR exemption thru 2027 as a non-member and 585 DP World Tour Race to Dubai Points

Additional Player Notes

- **Ben James** (2nd/-16) posts a 5-under 67 to sit two shots back after the third round; seeks first TOUR victory in 5th career start on TOUR since turning professional
- **Max McGreevy** (T3/-14) cards 7-under 65, matching the low round of the day with **Will Gordon** and **John VanDerLaan**; seeks his first PGA TOUR title in his 119th career start
- Italian **Stefano Mazzoli** (T3/-14) posts 6-under 66 in the third round, setting his career-low 18-hole score on TOUR (previous: 69/R2/2026 ISCO Championship); seeks first victory on the PGA TOUR in third career start
- **Gordon Sargent** (T3/-14) cards a third-round 69, highlighted by an eagle on No. 4; the Vanderbilt University grad seeks his first PGA TOUR victory in his 31st career start
- 19-year-old **Blades Brown** (T6/-13) cards 5-under 67 in the third round, highlighted by an eagle on No. 7; seeks first TOUR win in his 18th career start; currently holds Special Temporary Membership on the PGA TOUR, with a win would earn a one-year exemption thru 2027 as a non-member
- 2021 Corales Puntacana Championship winner **Joel Dahmen** (T16/-10) cards 3-under 69 and sits eight shots off the lead; seeks his second TOUR victory in his 255th start and to become the first multiple winner of the event
