Stefano Mazzoli (1st/-20)

- Earns his first career PGA TOUR victory in his third career start at the age of 29 years, 6 months, 23 days
- First non-member to win on TOUR since Alex Fitzpatrick (2026 Zurich Classic of New Orleans)
- 11th international winner on TOUR this season and first player from Italy to win the Corales Puntacana Championship
- Sixth first-time winner on TOUR this season (most recent: Bud Cauley/RBC Canadian Open)
- Joins the following players to earn their first career TOUR title at the Corales Puntacana Championship: Matt Wallace (2023), Chad Ramey (2022), Joel Dahmen (2021), Brice Garnett (2018)
- Wins in tournament debut at the Corales Puntacana Championship
- Earns 585 DP World Tour Race to Dubai Points and moves from No. 127 to No. 39 in the DP World Tour Race to Dubai Rankings
- Italian earns a PGA TOUR card through 2027
- After entering the final round four shots back, cards a 6-under 66 to win by one
- Four strokes marks the largest come-from-behind victory in tournament history (previous: 3 strokes, Billy Horschel/2024, Garrick Higgo/2025)

Additional Player Notes

- **Gordon Sargent** (T2/-19) posts 5-under 67 in the final round; records career-best finish on TOUR in his 31st start
- 18-, 36-, and 54-hole leader/co-leader, **Todd Clements** (T2/-19) earns his best finish on TOUR in his seventh career start (previous best: 3rd/2025 Barracuda Championship)
- **Will Gordon** (T4/-18) earns his first top-10 finish in 20 starts on TOUR (last top-10 finish: T5/2025 CJ CUP Byron Nelson)
- In his fifth start since turning professional, **Ben James** (T4/-18) records his first top-10 finish on TOUR (previous best: T15/2026 ISCO Championship)
- **Davis Bryant** (T11/-15) cards seven consecutive birdies on Nos. 2-8 for a front-nine 29, setting a career-best birdie streak (previous best: three birdies/R3/2026 ISCO Championship) and tournament record for most consecutive birdies
- **Luke List** (T15/-14) cards an 8-under 64 in the final round, one shy of his career low-round score (63, three times; most recent: 2021 John Deere Classic/R2)
- Final-round scores for the four past champions in the field: **Joel Dahmen** (T24/-12), **Garrick Higgo** (T48/-8), **Chad Ramey** (T62/-7), **Brice Garnett** (MC)
